Bishop's Easter Message.

My dear family in Christ, "Why do you seek the living one among the dead?" (Lk 24:5). This guestion posed by the angels to the women who had come to mourn at the tomb of Jesus has always struck me as something I need to ask myself on regular basis. It seems that there are times in my life of faith when I forget that the Lord is risen. I think of him as a historical figure from the past who is but a distant memory. Saint Luke offers us another reminder of this in the story on the disciples on the road to Emmaus, "How foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke!" (Lk 24:25). I sometimes forget that what we celebrate on Easter and every day since the resurrection is the fact that Jesus is alive and continues to be part of our lives. He is not just a memory, but the victorious Lord of Life who intercedes for His people redeemed by his suffering and death. The wonder of the resurrection of the Lord is meant to provide us with hope and strength throughout our lives because Jesus lives no more to die. It is my hope that all of us experience the joy of Easter today and throughout the coming 50 days. The truth of Christ's resurrection is too important to relegate to only one day and so we should celebrate this victory with gusto for the entire season, all the way through Pentecost. Let's not be too quick to set aside Easter iov for things which are much less important. Be assured of my prayers for you and your families, as I ask your kind prayers for me and my ministry as your bishop.
