A Window into Our Stained Glass Windows

The Most Holy Trinity is portrayed in two different ways in the windows. Most prominent is in the top of the sanctuary above the altar with three small triangular windows: the Father on the left as a hand, Christ in the center as a lamb, and the Holy Spirit on the right as a dove.

You may have missed the other way: three intertwined fish at the top of the second to last window in the front left of the church. This image focuses on the dynamic relationship between the persons of the Trinity and reminds us that the very essence of God is an dynamic community of love. The emphasis on mystery and not isolated and easily communicated facts.

The fancy theological word for this is "perichoresis," summed up by the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Edmonton on September 15, 2021: "When we speak of the Trinity, we must speak of perichoresis – literally the "choreographed dancing" or simultaneous inter penetration/indwelling of all three divine persons with and within each other. This dance of love pours itself out and God, as Triune Love, reaches out to us and invites us into this ever-dynamic movement of love."

In putting this together I noticed that very similar images are in the heart of Montpelier. This traffic sign is on Main St. shortly before you get to the rotary. The same one is on Spring St. before you cross the bridge, and a slightly different one just after Main Street Middle School. So when we drive through the rotary, we are mimicking with our neighbors the perichoresis of the Holy Trinity.
