This week we look at the other Thomas Waterman Wood painting

that hangs in the back of St. Augustine Church, his copy of *The Virgin of the Rosary* by Bartolomé Esteban Murillo (1617-1682). Wood went to London to copy the painting and gave it to St. Augustine. The gift was so notable that Bishop De Gosbriand came to St. Augustine to consecrate it, described here in the December 1897 issue of *The Vermonter*.

"One of the finest paintings now existing in the State is the artist's [Wood] superb

copy of Murillo's *La Madonna del Rosario*. This work which translates the original with infinite tenderness and a wonderful depth of feeling was painted in 1896 in the Dulwich Gallery and consecrated with great ceremony by Bishop De Gosbriand Monday evening July 26, 1897. Its final resting place will be the altar of the new Church of the Saint Augustine now in process of building.

This composition presents the Virgin and

Child seated upon the clouds of heaven and surrounded by adoring child angels. The mother holds the Christ child on her left arm. In her right hand she has the rosary which the Holy Infant also touches with his fingers The essential force of this work is its actual power to impress the beholder with a profound sense of the sacredness of motherhood and of the worth of purity and its effect is to inspire devotion. In the eloquent words with which at the time the reverend Father accepted this painting for his Church he said 'You have made the great Murillo of the 17th century our contemporary."
