#### **VERMONT** JUBILEE OF HOPE CONVOCATION

#### July 17, Brattleboro • July 18, Barre • July 19, Newport

A ll are invited to join us for the 2025 Diocesan Convocation to be held on July 17, 18, and 19 throughout the Diocese of Burlington. The convocation this year takes as its theme the Jubilee Year of Hope.

The word "convocation" comes from a Latin word that means "to come together" — particularly, for a special purpose. It is an opportunity for Catholics around the diocese to come together, beyond parish borders, for a time of prayer, formation, and fellowship. Our diocese often hosts half-day or one-day gatherings for various groups of people, but this expanded opportunity allows any Catholic — no matter how they are involved in their parishes (or how much or how little they are involved) — to participate.

The first evening, Thursday, July 17, will be held at Saint Michael the Archangel Parish in Brattleboro from 5:00 – 8:00 p.m. The theme of this evening is "Hope and the Sacred Heart: A Balm Amidst Hardship" and features Father Lance Harlow, pastor of Corpus Christi Parish in St. Johnsbury, offering the keynote presentation. Whether we are experiencing difficulty of any kind in our own life or are close to those who are, this evening will allow us to draw closer to the love that emanates from the Sacred Heart of Jesus which gives all of us reason to hope. The evening includes a pot-luck dinner and time of Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. There will be an opportunity for confessions.

The second evening, Friday, July 18 will take place at St. Monica Parish in Barre from 5:00-8:00 p.m. This evening features Ms. Rachel Lavallee, a youth minister and teacher in our diocese, who will speak on the theme of becoming Witnesses to Hope through the sharing of our faith stories. All of us are called to share the Good News of Jesus Christ, and if we take up this Christian call, we become witnesses to

Hope. Hear different witnesses through the generations and be inspired to think about your own faith witness. The evening again features a pot-luck dinner and time of Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, with praise and worship music offered by the young adults of our diocese. Again, there will be an opportunity for confessions.

The final night, Saturday, July 19 will take place at St. Mary, Star of the Sea in Newport on the beautiful shore of Lake Memphremagog. The evening begins with Mass celebrated by Bishop McDermott at 4:00 p.m., followed by an outdoor dinner, and a presentation from Monsignor Richard Lavalley, Pastor Emeritus of St. Francis Xavier Parish in Winooski, on Mary as Model and Source of Hope. Mass this evening will include the celebration of the Anointing of the Sick. The evening concludes with a Rosary commending the Diocese of Burlington to Mary, Mother of Divine Hope.

In the Jubilee Year of Hope, the late Pope Francis called each of us to become agents of hope. With that call in mind, each evening will feature a simple charitable activity you can partake in: donating food items for the St. Brigid's Kitchen food pantry in Brattleboro, donating school supplies for use at St. Monica-St. Michael School in Barre, and writing greeting cards for those in our Vermont Catholic Charities residential care homes or cards of support for clients at pregnancy centers throughout Vermont.
