# Founder's Day of Giving — July 29

n July 29, 1853, the Diocese of Burlington was founded with Bishop Louis de Goësbriand as its first bishop. Each year on this date, the Bishop's Annual Appeal celebrates Founder's Day of Giving — honoring the legacy of the clergy and laity who helped build the Church in Vermont.

We have not been without difficulties over these last 172 years, and today we continue to face many challenges in our diocese, including Chapter 11 reorganization. Yet we hope through prayer and steadfast faith in God, we will overcome all obstacles.

This hope is alive in so many ways across our diocese. At Easter, 114 individuals were welcomed into the Church through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. More than 2,000 students are receiving a Catholic education in Vermont, and 1,301 households received vital support through Vermont Catholic Charities' emergency aid program in 2024. Hundreds of Catholics of all ages are deepening their faith through retreats, Totus Tuus, marriage preparation, and the Steubenville East Conference, offered by the Office of Pastoral Ministries. Most importantly, thousands of faithful Catholics in Vermont gather each weekend to celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

These are real signs of hope — and they are made possible by you. It is only with your support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal that the Diocese of Burlington can continue to provide these essential ministries and services and ensure that we will be able to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ.
