NOVEMBER 6: ST. THEOPHANE VENARD

Theophane’s family loved God; he had a brother that was a priest and a brother who was a Bishop. When Theophane was old enough he became a priest, too. He wanted to be a missionary to share the good news of Jesus with people who didn’t know about Him. It was hard for Theophane to leave his family but he knew God wanted him to go share the Gospel. He went to Hong Kong to learn a new language. Then he went to Vietnam where Christians were put in prison and killed. Theophane was in danger and would get sick often. Even though it was difficult to be there, Theophane kept sharing about God and many people gave their life to Jesus. He was well loved by the people he served but, one day, someone betrayed him, just like Judas betrayed Jesus. Theophane was thrown into prison for two months. While there he shared the Gospel with the guards and they gave their lives to Jesus. Even though people tried to save his life, the ruler of Vietnam did not like Christians and he had Theophane killed as a martyr.
