

GAUDETE SUNDAY

The third Sunday of Advent, known as Gaudete Sunday, is commonly marked by the use of Cerise-rose colored—vest-ments. The term is derived from the opening words-in Latin—of the introit, "Rejoice (Gaudete) in the Lord always." This prayer is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await His coming not with fear, but with great joy.
