SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL BY LAWS

ARTICLE 1 - MEMBERS

ARTICLE 1 - MEMBERS	
Section 1	The Advisory Council will consists of the following members:
	At least one (1) member from Saint Mary's Parish with no children in the school who is appointed by the Pastor.
	At least two (2) persons from Saint Mary Parish with children in the school who are elected.
	At least one (1) person from outside Saint Mary Parish with children in the school.
	At least two (2) persons who serve as at-large members, appointed by the Pastor of Saint Mary Parish.
	At least one (1) person who is an officer in the PTO and who will represent the PTO.
Section 2	Members should have a strong and positive commitment to Catholic school education.
Section 3	Members are required to participate in all scheduled meetings.
Section 4	All Council members shall serve a minimum of one two year term.
Section 5	Any vacancy during a term may be filled by the Pastor.
	ARTICLE II – ELECTION OF MEMBERS
Section 1	A nomination committee is established at the beginning of the New Year to seek future possible board members.
Section 2	Voting Ballots for future Advisory Council members will be sent home and asked to be returned within two weeks.
Section 4	New members are to be selected prior the last quarterly meeting and take office on July 1.
Section 5	Only one member of a family is eligible for Advisory Council membership at any one time.

Section 6 Employees of the school or their immediate family members are not eligible to be voting members of the Advisory Council.

ARTICLE III -REMOVAL OF MEMBERS

- Section 1 The Advisory Council, with the approval of the pastor, may declare vacant the office of an Advisory Council member on the occurrence of any of the following events:
 - a) The absence from three (3) Council meetings in any school year without adequate explanation;
 - b) Any act or course of conduct that is inconsistent with the mission of the school and/or diocese.
 - c) The refusal or inability of a member to perform his/her duties in a conscientious or responsible manner.

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

- Section 1 The President of the school Advisory Council will be appointed by the pastor for the coming year at the last quarterly meeting.
- Section 2 Members are limited to holding the same office for not more than two consecutive terms.

ARTICLE V-COMMITTEES

- Section 1 Each member of the Advisory Council should sit on at least one standing committee.
- Section 2 The Pastor, Principal and President will be an ex-officio member of all committees.
- Section 3 Individuals who are not Council members may serve as members of any committee.
- Section 4 Standing Committees include:
 - a) Financial
 - b) Facility
 - c) Nominating

ARTICLE VI - AMENDMENTS

Section 1 These By-laws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the Advisory Council voting at a regular meeting. Advisory Council members must receive written notice about By-law amendments prior to the vote to amend.
