Please read the following and discuss with your parents/guardian(s). Sign and return.

In room 106 and on Saint Mary Catholic School campus, I will do the following:

1. Follow directions QUICKLY.
2. Raise my hand to speak.
3. Raise my hand to move from my seat.
4. Make smart choices.
5. Make our dear teacher happy (follow the rules and be kind).

Consequences: Every decision one makes in life has a consequence. Good decisions have good consequences, bad decisions and disobedience have bad consequences.

When a student does not follow the classroom rules, Mrs. Mabry will give three chances for students to collect themselves and follow the rules again. If a student does not follow the classroom rules after three chances, they will be removed from the current activity and they will need to complete any work missed at home. If obeying the classroom rules becomes a consistent problem and the student needs to be dismissed from the classroom because of consistent, disruptive behavior, the student will not be able to make-up any missed work.

Rewards:

When I follow the classroom rules, I will have an opportunity to become a "Self-Manager." A self-manager is one who can manage themselves with Christ-like behavior all while following classroom rules. To become a self-manager, one must apply for the position during recess. If awarded a self-manager position, your name tag will be upgraded to a self manager name tag, and you will be able to have a classroom job that earns Mabry Money every week. Mabry Money can be spent in the Marvelous Mabry Store at the end of the school year.
