Message from Father Doug Halsema, Pastor of Saint Mary Catholic Church

"Where there is no vision, the people perish."

Proverbs 29:18a

You may be wondering what our vision for Saint Mary is. Do we have a vision, mission, strategies, and clearly stated values? We do.

Inspired by the Holy Spirit and rooted in an environment of prayerful discernment and open discourse over the years, we have asked ourselves four very important questions to discern our parish vison, mission, values, and strategies. We call these clarity questions because they clarify who we are, how we behave, and what we do.



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Clarity Questions Our Parish Playbook

1. Why do we exist?

To be "a place where it becomes impossible not to share Jesus with the world." Acts 4:20 --It is impossible for us not to speak about what we have seen and heard.

- 2. How do we behave? (What are the behavioral values we embrace?)
 - 1) We are Committed to the Journey and the Process
 - 2) We are Joyfully Relational
 - 3) We have a Solution Finding Spirit.
- 3. What do we do? (What must your parish actually do?)

We experience Jesus personally through Mass, sacraments, prayer, evangelizing, discipling, community, and service.

- 4. How will we succeed? (Three anchors through which all decisions must be viewed.)
 - 1)Faith in the home Are we providing the support necessary for families young and old to live out their faith in the home?
 - 2) Equip to evangelize Are we giving our parishioners the tools, training, and encouragement they need to share their faith beyond the parish?
 - 3) Strive for excellence Are we providing the most compelling, attractive, and high quality experience possible?
- 5. What is most important-right now?

This is our current Thematic Goal: Unite Church and School as One Holy Family

6. Who must do what? See the Amazing Parish Scorecard's defining objectives which describes who does what to achieve the Thematic Goal.

The answers to these four clarity questions determine our parish culture, how we communicate and behave, what we communicate, all decision-making, and all planning going forward. Why? It is because we want to be a place where it becomes impossible not to share Jesus with the rest of the world!
