

Any form of prayer is appropriate during Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Here are a couple of suggestions to consider:

<u>Praise</u>: Offer praise to God by reading the Psalms that are Songs of Praise (e.g., 23, 56, 95, 98, 100, 117, 139, 145, and 150) St. Faustina's prayer: I adore You, Lord and Creator, hidden in the Most Blessed Sacrament. I adore You for all the works of Your hands, that reveal to me so much wisdom, goodness and mercy, O Lord. And although You have hidden Yourself and concealed your beauty, my eye, enlightened by faith, reaches You and my soul recognizes its Creator, its Highest Good, and my heart is completely immersed in prayer of adoration.

<u>Chanting</u>: "I adore you, O Christ, present here and in all the churches of the world, for by your holy cross you have redeemed the world." St Francis of Assisi

<u>Scripture</u>: Look at the readings for the day or for the upcoming Sunday liturgy. Be aware of anything in the passage that stands out for you. Then ask the Lord to enlighten your heart on those passages. Remember to sit quietly and listen for his response!

<u>Pray the Rosary</u>: As we know, Mary is the perfect disciple and, as his mother, is united with Jesus in a uniquely special way. St. John Paul II wrote: "...is not the enraptured gaze of Mary as she contemplated the face of the newborn Christ and cradled him in her arms that unparalleled model of love which should inspire us every time we receive Eucharistic communion?"


