Father Flum approached me and asked if I would sign up for a weekly Adoration time. I was not sure if I could make a commitment at that time, and I guess the look on my face told him, I was not sure. He said, "Try it for a few weeks," and so I did. That was the beginning.

Initially, I had no clue what to do, or what to say to the Lord for an hour. By God's grace, I found a sheet of paper in the back of the church with the title, "Be Still and Know that I am God." It was written by America Needs Fatima.

What a blessing this sheet was! It provided me with the questions that I could answer prayerfully in God's presence. For example: do you need to ask a favor on someone's behalf? Are you sad or in a bad humor?

God was present on the altar that afternoon, and I asked Him why my friend had to die. More tears followed. I continued to tell God about my sorrowful visit and how much the friendship meant to me. I knew I needed help to overcome my sorrow. So, I sat, prayed, and realized that Jesus was setting right next to me giving comfort, and guidance. Finally, peace overcame me, and I knew God was truly present.

Come and give an hour to our Lord Jesus Christ, He has so much to give you. Do not wait to enjoy the Real Presence of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Tell Him everything from your heart. You will realize all the blessings that He has bestowed on you and your family.



"Proclaiming the Kingdom" systematically unpacks the riches of the Gospel of

Matthew. Sometimes called "the Gospel of the Kingdom" because of its central theme, Matthew was the most often quoted of the four gospels in the writings of the early Church Fathers. These talks were originally delivered to an audience of priests and deacons on retreat at St. Vincent's Archabbey in Latrobe, Pennsylvania. They are both theologically rich and eminently practical. To get the most out of these presentations by Dr. Scott Hahn, Dr. Brant Pitre, and Dr. John Bergsma, you should read the chapters of Matthew once through before listening to the lecture.
