## Third Sunday of Lent

Sunday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

Reflection by St. Michael's Adorer, Mike Parra

I am a convert, who entered the Catholic Church skeptical of the real presence, never having heard of Eucharistic Adoration, and not even knowing what a monstrance was. I was blessed to have attended a strong RCIA program at Saint Mary of the Assumption in Upper Marlboro and to have a great sponsor that opened my eyes to the fulness of the Catholic faith. My sponsor took me to various talks, day retreats, holy hours, and healing Masses, allowing me to learn more and more about the faith. Stories about the Saints, particularly the life of Saint Padre Pio, the Marian apparitions, and the miracle of the sun at Fatima, and the many Eucharistic miracles convicted me of the truth of the real presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. A story of a Catholic explaining the real presence to a non-Catholic really resonated with me. After having heard the explanation, the non-Catholic could not understand why Catholics were not rushing to see Jesus Himself if they truly believed in the real presence. That made perfect sense to me and convinced me that I must visit with Jesus as much as I could. I was fortunate and blessed to have a parish that held Eucharistic Adoration every Tuesday from 8:30am until 9:00pm at night and frequently held 40-hour Adoration. The weekly bulletin each week encouraged adoration: "could you not watch with me even one hour?" I was then blessed with the opportunity to go on retreat to Fatima with a group that included Father Flum. Shortly after that trip, COVID hit, and Father Flum almost immediately started all day Adoration at Saint Michael's. What a blessing for this parish and community! Jesus thirsts for you, inviting you to spend time with him. I am thankful that Father Cusick and now Father Choi continue nearly daily adoration at Saint Michael's. Please come and spend time with Jesus; He is waiting for you.
