

#### **Faith Formation Information by Linda Hansmeier**

The early Christians focused on coming to know Christ in three powerful ways, through the sacraments, especially the Eucharist; the stories and emerging writings about Jesus; and his powerful presence when they gathered in his name.

God, is a relational God who constantly invites us, through prayer to come to know Him, on a more intimate level as we travel on our journey to reach the Kingdom of God. One method of prayer to use is Lectio Divina.

- Choose a Bible passage/s, or an epistle or Gospel reading. Finding a place of quiet, acknowledging God's presence, offer a prayer to the Holy Spirit for inspiration and guidance: "Come, Holy Spirit, enlighten my heart and mind to listen to your word."
- Read the text slowly and prayerfully.
- When a word of phrase strikes you, stop and rest with it.
- Prayer begins your dialogue with God that comes from your heart.
- Rest in God's presence and receive His transforming embrace, allowing God to act in you.
