

Happy Easter Season! It is with great excitement and deep joy that I want to welcome both parishioners and friends to our weekly encounter with the Lord and with one another. We are a parish family happily striving to encounter Jesus in our Sunday celebrations and share Him with others—old and new faces!

In fact, we have just entered one of the happiest moments of the year in our parish, the *Easter Season!* It's a hopeful time! It's a time we look forward to many exciting celebrations, including the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

Recently, we focused on three projects that each upheld the Option for the Poor and Vulnerable. **LENTEN ALMS:** This year for Lenten Alms, the Social Justice Committee asked for your help in sustaining the chapel schools of Notre Dame de Lourdes in Haiti. HOUSEHOLD GOODS: The Social Justice Committee sends a hearty thank you to St. John's faith community for the generous response to the collection of household goods for the Catherine McAuley Center during Lent. The committee collected over 228 items. The last of three car loads of donations was delivered on April 12.

GROCERY SACKS: Thank you for grocery sack donations which we share with St Pat's Catholic Church in Anamosa to make into sleeping mats for the homeless. The Willis Dady Homeless Center in Cedar Rapids has asked for at least 10 more mats every month due to increased need, and it takes over 500 sacks to make ONE MAT. We will continue to collect grocery sacks all summer and all year to help meet this goal. We appreciate your help for people in need!
