Our Annual Mass of Remembrance will be held on

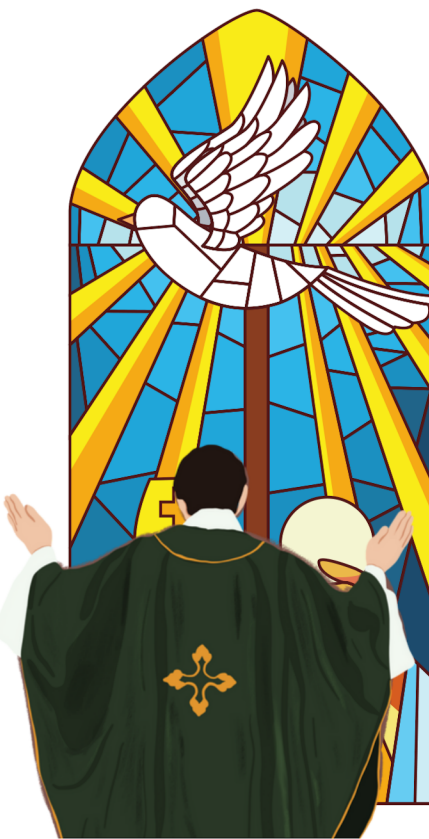
**Saturday, November 26, 2022 - 9:00 AM**
