**What is a Holy Hour?** A Holy Hour is a period of time (usually around an hour) spent in prayer before our Lord Jesus Christ present to us sacramentally in the Eucharist. This involves silent personal prayer, meditation, readings from Sacred Scripture, hymns, spoken prayers, and litanies, and can even involve popular devotions such as recitation of the Rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
