



RESIDENTIAL DORMITORY PROGRAM

2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Residential students live in a dedicated wing of a residence hall at Saint Michael's College, just 10 minutes from Rice. Students are supervised by four dedicated Rice Dorm Parents and a Residential Life Director who create a welcoming environment where students quickly feel at home.

Students Can Access College Amenities Including:

- Student Center: music, table tennis, pool table, comfy lounge chairs and fun space to hang out with friends
- Dining Hall: multiple food options, complete meals, allergy friendly
- Additional Dining Options: bagels, burgers, fries right on campus and open at extended hours
- Fitness center, library, chapel, lawns

Weekend Activities

- Weekend excursions feature popular activities including: hiking, skiing, shopping, harvest festivals, pickleball, pumpkin picking, apple picking, hay rides, maple syrup making, swimming, volunteering and more
- Sightseeing: Stowe, Ben & Jerry's, the waterfront, downtown
- Most activities included in the cost of tuition

What to Expect:

- **Students will have a roommate** and live with other Rice students
- Room size is about 198sq. feet and includes a bed, desk, and closet
- There is 24-hour supervision with 4 dedicated Dorm Parents
- Meals are included in the housing fee; personal funds needed for special purchases outside the dining hall
- Transportation to school and activities is included
- The dorms are closed over Christmas break; however, students may stay in dorms over other school breaks for a daily fee

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Note: We will take a group shopping trip to Target and Staples during orientation, so you don't have to bring everything with you.

BEDDING

- sheets, blankets, comforter, pillows
- optional: bed risers, an egg crate or mattress pad

DESK

- desk lamp (you will definitely need this!)
- computer & chargers
- power strip with on/off switch
- basic school supplies: pens, pencils, paper, notebooks etc.

FOR FOOD:

- optional: dishes, utensils, sponge, dish soap, water bottle, small refrigerator
- note: microwaves are available in the common room

FOR YOUR ROOM:

- mirrors, posters, collages, tapestries
- window fan & extension cord

SHOWER

- required: shower caddy, towels, bath robe, flip flops or other shower shoes
- toiletries: shampoo, conditioner, razors, soap, toothbrush etc.

LAUNDRY:

Laundry is self service and has its own fees associated with it. Students use the "Laundry Connect Pay" app to pay. Students may want a laundry bag or basket, detergent, drying rack and clothes hangers. An iron and ironing board is available.

MEDICATION

We have a basic first aid kit. All prescription and over the counter medication is stored in a locked cabinet. If you use medication regularly, please bring it and have it labeled in a clear ziplock bag.

DO NOT BRING

Students MAY NOT bring the following items into their dormitory rooms at any time during the year:

- candles or incense
- space heater
- electric cookware
- electric blanket
- air conditioners
- hot tubs
- water beds
- exterior holiday lights
- lava lamp
- halogen lights
- pets (including fish bowls)
- knives or other weapons
