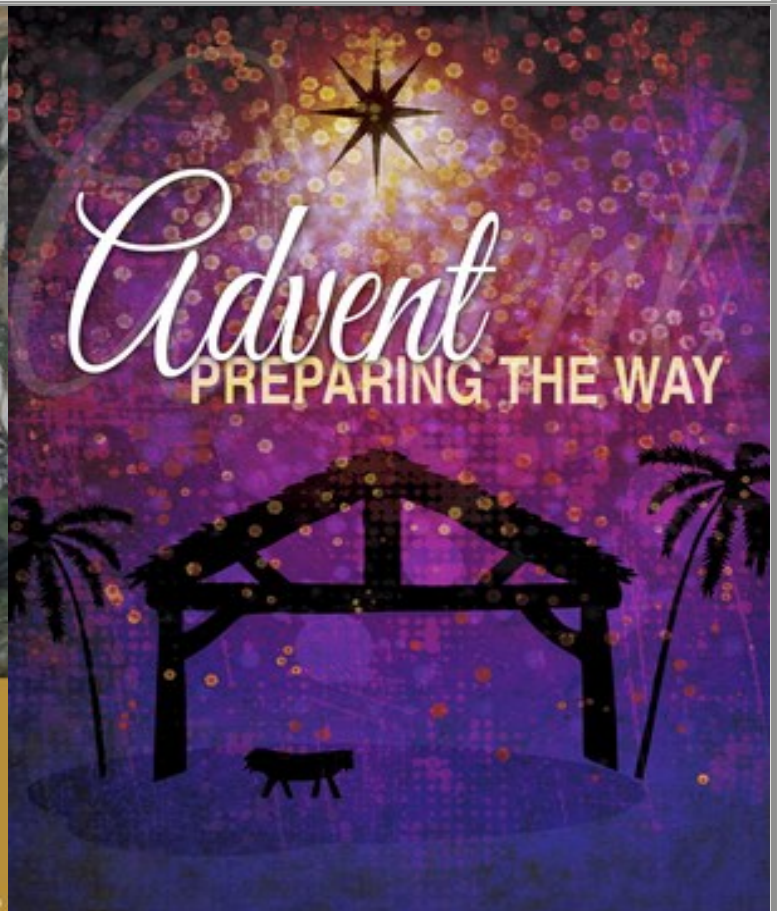

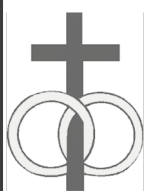

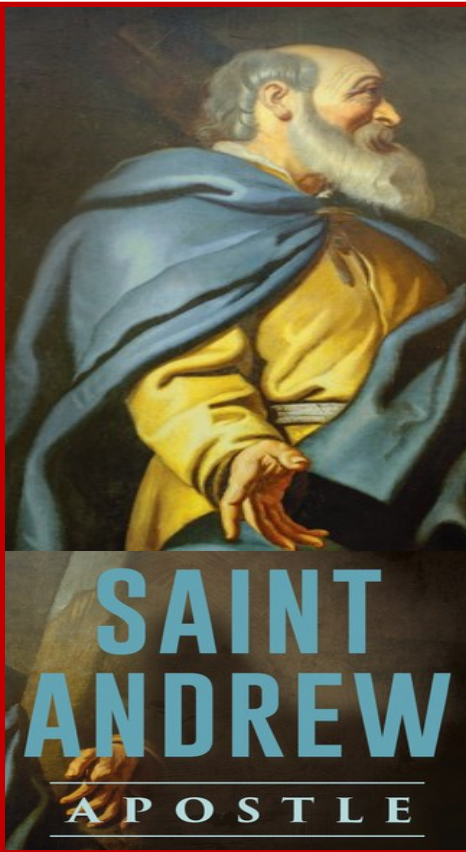
PRAYER
