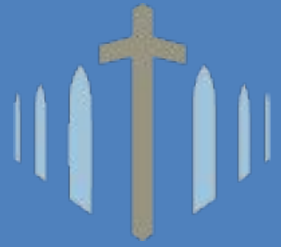

Confirmation Information



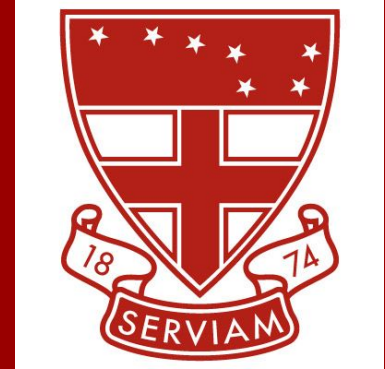
- Confirmation - Thursday, March 7th @ 6pm
- Diocese has not determined the celebrant
- Each confirmant will need a confirmation sponsor
 - At least 16 or older
 - practicing Catholic
 - Fully initiated, has received the sacraments of baptism, eucharist, confirmation
 - If married, married in the Catholic Church
- Girls wear a white dress, Boys wear a suit/tie
- Confirmation Saint
- Pines Confirmation Retreat (January 24 - 26)

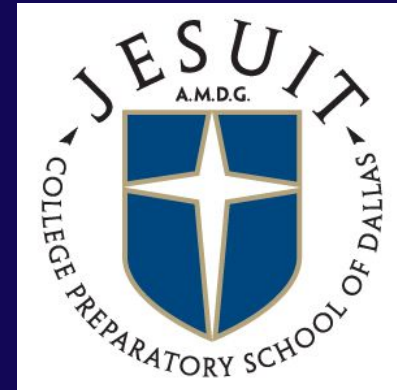

- Transcripts due: 1/12/24
- Recommendations due: 1/12/24
- ISEE - take by 2/2/2024 (441825 reporting code)
- Student interviews: 1/13/24 and 1/20/24 (in person, 15 minutes and student only)
- Decisions: 3/8/24
- Enroll by: 3/22/24

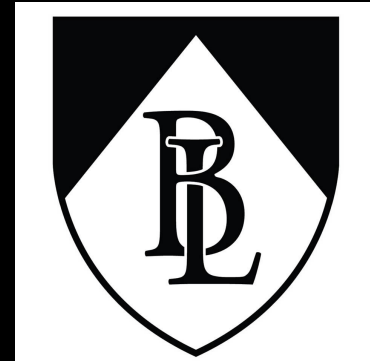

 - mid September
 - deadline: 1/12/24
- Recommendations deadline: 2/2/24
- Student Activity Sheet; Student and Parent Profile Responses due: 2/2/234
- Transcripts due: 2/2/24
- Student interviews: 1/13/24 and 1/20/24
- ISEE - take by 2/3/24
- Decisions: 3/8/24
- Enroll by: 3/22/24

BISHOP LYNCH

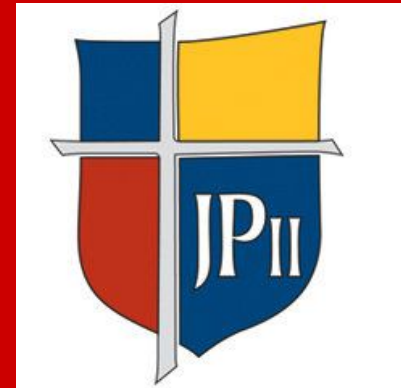
- Application
 - opens: 9/15/23
 - deadline: 1/12/24
- Transcripts due: 1/19/24
- Recommendation forms due: 1/19/24
- Family Interviews : February
- Decisions: 3/8/24
- Enroll by: 3/27/24

JP II

- Application
 - opens: 10/2/23
 - deadline: 1/12/24
- Recommendations deadline: 2/16/24
- Transcripts due: 2/16/24
- Student interviews: 1/20/24 and 2/10/24
- ISEE - take by 2/3/24
- Decisions: 3/8/24
- Enroll by: 3/22/24



Timeline of the Application Process

CISTERCIAN

- Different from all other Catholic High schools
- Application deadline: 1/15/24
- Records due: 1/27/24 (transcript, IOWA, attendance, immunization, teacher evaluations)
- Admission Exam dates: 1/28/24, 2/4/24
- Decisions: 3/10/24 after 4pm
- Informal interviews

NOT done through Ravenna!

How is my student evaluated?

1. Transcript for grades 7th & fall of 8th grade

- The student has demonstrated a history of appropriate motivation and effort.
- Grades are consistent and compatible with ability.
- Improvement has been made in areas of struggle.
- Includes 7th and 8th grade IOWA test scores

Conduct & Behavioral Performance

- Student has consistently demonstrated cooperation with school rules and regulations.
- Conduct grades on report cards reflect cooperation with school behavioral expectations.

Attendance Records

- Student has demonstrated a history of consistent attendance. Be ready to document any attendance gaps on record.

How is my student evaluated?

2. Personal Interviews - We will conduct mock interviews at SMS

- Mock interviews will be conducted in January upon our return from Christmas Break. Dates and times to come.

We strongly recommend students do two mock interviews. Sign-up information to come.

Application - What to do now?

- **Learn about high schools - visit websites**

 - Study course offerings, extra curricular activities, clubs, athletics
 - Contact admission directors with questions

Application - What to do now?

Request Recommendations - electronic

- Current Math & Language Arts Teachers
- JP II: Current Math or Science teachers and current English or Social Studies teacher
- 3rd recommendation:
 - Principal specific recommendations to President
 - Student choice for Jesuit, Ursuline and JP II
 - Principal or Assistant Principal for Bishop Lynch
 - Principal or Counselor for Bishop Dunne
 - Do not request a large number of recommendations!

Submit Transcript Release form to SMS

- Required for each school where you are applying
- Print and sign - through Ravenna
- Submit signed forms to Stephanie Burgess - SMS registrar - she will send transcripts to high schools.

Interview

- Evaluated based on
 - **First impressions** on general appearance and dress
 - Be on time.
 - Dress appropriately (Sunday best).
 - **Eye contact and handshake**
 - Give a firm handshake.
 - Introduce yourself with your first and last name.
 - Thank the interviewer before leaving.
 - **Articulate your thoughts**
 - **Body language**
 - Sit up straight; don't cross your legs.
 - Try not to shake or tap nervously.
 - **Responses to interview questions**
 - Try to answer concisely and not ramble.
 - Ask the interviewer to repeat the question if you misunderstand it.
- **Demonstrate interest - have a question ready to ask!**

- **Testing options**

- **at St. Monica** - 1/13/2023 (8:30 a.m.)
- Other testing sites (schools and prometric testing centers) in the Dallas area
- At home testing
- Only one testing per testing season (Dec-March)

Scores prior to december will not be accepted.

- **Cost**

- \$155.00 - school testing sites
- \$200 - at home online/prometric testing centers

- Reports may be sent to **6** schools.
- Only one registration per season (Dec-Jan-Feb-March).
- We request that you indicate St. Monica as one of the recipients of your child's score. The school code for St. Monica is **570275**

ISEE: Format and Scoring

Section	Questions	Time allotted
Verbal reasoning	40	20 minutes
Quantitative reasoning	37	35 minutes
Break		
Reading comprehension	36	35 minutes
Math achievement	47	40 minutes

Essay	1 prompt	30 minutes

Total Time : 2 hours 40 minutes plus 2 breaks

ISEE: Format and Scoring

Scoring:

- Scored by ERB nationally
- Norm Referenced - national %-ile and Stanine score
- The essay is sent to each high school for evaluation.
- Parents will not have access to the scored essay.
- Takes about 14 days
- Scores reported on the parent ERB account

ISEE Testing with Accommodations

Available at St. Monica

- ★ Available for students who have a diagnosed learning difference AND have an IAP
- ★ Testing accommodation must be approved by ISEE before registering for the test.
- ★ 50% extra time

ISEE: The Day of the Test

- **Be sure of the date, time, and place.**
 - Arrive 15-30 minutes early to avoid last minute anxiety.
