Are parents allowed to shop with their student(s)?

§ Parents with Safe Environment badges are welcome to shop with their student(s) during the school day. You will need to enter at McManus Hall and sign in with our receptionist before coming into the library.

§ It is NOT required that parents be onsite for their student to shop.

§ **Please be aware volunteers and staff are there to help the students, but are not responsible for monitoring specific items/titles your child purchases. Please review with your student your expectations on what they should or should not purchase.**

How can students pay for items?

§ **Scholastic has a convenient E-Wallet.** This is a loadable account, similar to an electronic gift card that students can use to purchase items. The staff members working at the registers will scan the barcode when the student(s) are ready to make their purchase. If your student forgets or loses their barcode, don't worry! § **Cash** - Please send cash in a Ziplock bag with the student's name printed clearly on the bag.

§ **Check** - Made out to St. Monica Catholic School

§ If your student does not have enough money for their entire purchase, volunteers and SMS staff will help the student add up the total cost of their items so the student can choose what they want to buy the most.

§ Please talk with your students about what items they may want to buy.

§ Feel free to write a "[Wish List](#)" of titles, characters, etc. they may want to purchase. This may also assist staff and volunteers if your student needs help choosing items.

§ Talk about their budget and how much they can spend.

§ Don't forget to add in TAX. Scholastic does charge tax on their purchases. The tax is 8.25%

§ Please be aware volunteers and staff are there to help the students, but are not responsible for monitoring specific items/titles your child purchases. Please review with your student your expectations on what they should or should not purchase.
