The symbolism of the wreath with its evergreens and circular shape signify the immortality of our souls and the new everlasting life promised to us in Christ, the eternal Word of the Father who entered human history, fully human, fully divine.





This book is provided to parishioners as a gift from members of the St. Therese Guild.


