

### Mass Schedule

**Weekday 9:00 am Mass:** Reservations are no longer needed.

**Sunday Mass:** Reservations for the 8:30 and 10:30 am Sunday Masses are required and can be made by calling the Pastoral Office at (626) 291-5900 by 3:00 pm on Friday of each week. These are the only weekend Masses offered at this time. Please also call the office by Noon on Fridays if you need to cancel a reservation.

### 'Drive-thru' Communion Reception Line

For those who prefer not to come to public mass at this time, there will be a "drive thru" communion line offered each Sunday from 11:45 am to 12:20 pm. Please line up going south on Cloverly Avenue by car and turn into the church parking lot. PLEASE DO NOT PARK.

We will stand and distribute communion to people in the car in the hand. Please wear a mask as we approach your car. Drive off safely through exit on Broadway.

### 'Drive-thru' Confessions

"Drive-thru" Confessions will now be offered at 1:00 pm on Saturdays. Please wear a mask and drive through the church parking lot where you will be directed through the back alley to approach one of the priests who will hear your brief confession from outside the passenger side of the car.

If there are multiple people in the car, the passenger/s may exit and stand at a safe distance and we will come to them after hearing the driver's confession. This is not a prolonged counseling moment: we want anybody who wants a brief confession following these months of lockdown to have the opportunity, so please be prepared and expedient. Please drive out safely the rear gate onto Live Oak Avenue.

### Pastoral Office Hours

The Pastoral Office is open to the public 8:00 am-5:00 pm (Monday-Friday) for church business. Please be reminded that we are still under the county health order, so we ask that parishioners only visit the office if it's absolutely necessary for church business.

- Face coverings are required when visiting the office and try to keep your visit brief.
- Staff are available by phone and e-mail as well.
- Items can left in office mailbox; it's checked regularly.
- Please be reminded that the Chapel is still closed and no parish-related meetings, events or activities are being conducted on or off property at this time (Room reservations for activities are not being accepted at this time as well.).
- There are no other sacraments that are being scheduled or performed at this time.
- Eucharistic Ministers should not visit the sick.





We live in an age and a society that has never been more educated or had a higher standard of living, yet never have we carried as much debt. Many are living beyond their means. We have so many resources and time-saving devices at our hands, yet our lives are more complex than ever. While many people may not engage in extreme manual labor we rarely escape our jobs. Many are connected through phones and constantly receive calls, texts, and emails. Others spend hours in traffic on their daily commutes or pack on the frequent flyer miles.

We spend hours binge-watching our favorite shows. Many children are accustomed to being in front of a screen all the time and no longer know how to play creatively. The statistics for those who continue to leave the Church and all forms of organized religion also continue to rise.

While there is no such thing as a “good old days” to return to, there was something to be said for sleeping soundly after putting in a good day’s work, and for a family gathering around the table for a shared meal. For many, this model for eucharist rarely exists. Jesus knows and feels our pains, and

calls out, “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.”

### IT’S NOT ROCKET SCIENCE

So how do we declutter? Downsize? Devote ourselves again to Christ and live out our gospel calling? Sign up for a liturgical ministry, or volunteer to help with a religion program. Join a small faith group. Volunteer at a food pantry or Habitat for Humanity. Become involved as an individual, or a family. Meanwhile, back at the house, make a commitment to go through one drawer a day, and take things to your local St. Vinnie’s or secondhand store. Remember meal and bedtime prayers. Find a minute to read the daily scriptures. Take many baby steps. It’s not rocket science. It is a continual commitment to bring ourselves as we are, and to respond to Jesus’ call to “Come.”

### Tips for keeping calm and parenting during stressful times

We are living in unprecedented times, and many parents are stretched to capacity. The added stress of pandemic living can make it hard to parent calmly and effectively when children are acting out, but it’s important to remember that children are also going through a huge period of change right now. Instead of reacting in anger, try these ideas to keep you cool.

Talk to a friend – many people are suffering from a lack of physical community, so reach out by phone or text. # Important Reminders

- While on church property, please remember to maintain physical distance from others.
- Masks/Face Coverings are required out of respect for ALL those attending.
- The seating setup in the church also maintains physically distancing. The requirement of needing to be from the same household to sit together will not be strictly enforced, but is encouraged. Please make responsible decisions for you and your family.
- **Arrive early:** Doors open 30 minutes prior to the service and will be closed and locked when Mass begins. Late arrivals will not be admitted.
- Church entry will be from the main doors on Cloverly Avenue. Attendees will be checked in and ushered to their seat. Hand sanitizer will be available. Please know that pews will be sanitized after each service.
- A physical collection will not be taken during the Mass. We thank you for remembering St. Luke in your financial tithing during this very difficult time for all of us. Offerings can be mailed or dropped off at the Pastoral Office (can leave in the office mailbox) or contributed online.
- During Mass, we will not have a physical sign of peace. Singing will not take place and missalettes or songbooks will not be available in the pews for surface safety.
- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is extended indefinitely. People who are 65 or older, have a weakened immune system, or have a chronic medical condition are encouraged to stay home, especially since we are experiencing a spike in virus infections. If you are sick, you **MUST** remain at home. Please do not place yourself or others in danger of illness and death.

**As we continue to evaluate our current situation, we will re-evaluate all procedures and schedules and adapt to what current safety protocols or Archdiocesan directives are in place.**
