



St. Mary Mother of the Church turns 50 years in 2025. Our Anniversary celebrations will lead us to be and show how we have grown into an active, compassionate, evangelizing faith filled church. Our anniversary year will also have opportunities for us to come together in unique ways to strengthen our parish unity. Our celebration will not just be a Mass and reception, but a response and result of us being Church. The Year will have a focus on:

Sacraments, Charity, Ministry, the Beauty of our Faith and on Us – our outreach because of our FAITH.

Pilgrimage: to Mexico - Our Lady of Guadalupe - Patroness of the Americas – in late February 2025 to California - Mission Chapels – Wineries – Muir Woods – in October 2025

Three Special Masses in 2025:

January 1 – Solemnity of Mary Mother of God - 9:00 AM Mass, Focus on the Eucharist and the Liturgy - Celebrant to be Bishop Deshotel. He will dedicate a new Tabernacle (which was already donated to the Church) and a new chalice. This will begin the Anniversary Year.

June 9 - Feast Day – Mary Mother of the Church - 6:00 PM Mass, All Native Clergy Sons invited. Focus on vocation and how God calls each of us to spread holiness into the world.

December 8 – Closing Mass at 6:00 pm, with a focus on our history - dedicated in 1975
