A Shepard Who Loved Us



Today, the Church throughout the whole world mourns the death of Pope Francis (88 years old) who died on Monday of the Octave of Easter, April 21, 2025. Born, Jorge Mario Bergogilo, in Buenos Aires on December 17, 1936, he was one of five children. He truly cared for the poor while living a strict simplicity in his own lifestyle. He was ordained a priest for the Jesuit Order on December 13, 1969, Auxiliary Bishop of Buenos Aires on June 27, 1992, Coadjutor Archbishop on June 3, 1997, Archbishop in 1998 and Cardinal on February 21, 2001. He was elected Pope, Bishop of Rome, on March 13, 2013.

Pope Francis has been an advocate pointing out division and suffering, trying to bring healing and unity, so that all can identify as, and rejoice in being, God's Beloved Children. The Church will mourn our Holy Father's Death for nine days (known as Novendiale) which will most likely include his funeral and then a conclave will begin two to three weeks after the funeral so that the Holy Spirit can elect a new Holy Father through the College of Cardinals. This is an important time, as we pray for the soul of Pope Francis to receive eternal life and joy with God and all the saints. We also pray for our Church, that the Holy Spirit can truly guide the future steps of God's Instrument on earth.
