The young Jesus was independent. He decided to stay "in His Father's house" to talk with the scholars. He thought of this, and acted on it, on His own.

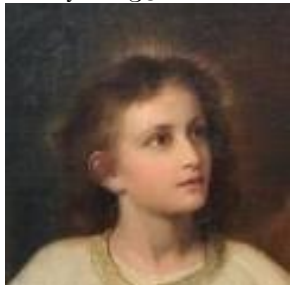
The young Jesus was obedient. The Gospel says clearly that He was obedient to His parents in all things.
