

Boys' hairstyles are to be neat and the length of hair should not touch the collar in back or be long enough to cover the ears. Hair should not cover the eyes or be at a length in the front so that hair needs to be pushed out of the eyes on a regular basis.

Too long in front



covers ears and collar



too long everywhere



All these shorts are too short



Regarding shorts – even for PE - They should be of knee length or approximately two/three or maybe four inches above the knee. The end of the shorts should be at the end of the thumb when arms and hands are held straight down. If they are shorter than that, they are not considered uniform and may not be worn.

Skirts and jumpers must be knee length – no shorter than three inches above the knee. This is a matter of modesty. If skirts/jumpers are too short, the hem must be altered or a new uniform must be purchased.



This is three inches – feel free to cut this out and tape it to the top of your daughter's knee to check for appropriate length – both in front and back of leg.



Dress pants do not have elastic on the bottom.

Sweaters may be of any style in a solid color of white, pale yellow, navy blue, black, gray, or hunter green and worn over the polo shirt. Sweaters with stripes, hearts, polka dots, etc. are not uniform. Hoodies (pull over or zip) must be removed once in the classroom.
