

SUNDAY GOSPEL REFLECTION

"Peace be with you."

__John 20:19

Journey with me my brothers and sister, to the upper room with our Lord. I can only imagine the uncertainty the disciples felt as they mourned the loss of their Shephard's physical presence in their lives, but how peaceful to know that He lives.

On this particular day, Jesus wants to encourage all of His followers. Thomas the one who refused to believe, unless he could touch the nail scarred hands of our Lord, and so many others who were not in the company but followed Jesus to the cross.

Close your eyes and picture this. It's been more than forth (40) days since the Lord left you and rose from the dead. Even though you remember what He taught you, and you know there is a mission, you are powerless to move out of that hidden space, surrounded by the ones you trust.



Confirmation 2022 – STA Youth




