During the Pro-Life Month of October, we will have the opportunity to help **WOMANKIND**, an organization that assists women with prenatal care.

For forty years, **WOMANKIND** has offered a full range of services for pregnant women and for families in medical, financial, and emotional need. In addition to pregnancy testing, **WOMANKIND** offers clinic care, counseling, and childbirth classes.

Next weekend, September 26-27, you will receive a baby bottle when you leave church. During the month of October please put your spare change in that bottle. Bring your (filled?) baby bottle to church on the last weekend of October (24-25).

St Charles last conducted a **Baby Bottle Fundraiser** four years ago. At that time, our parish collected more than \$11,000 in coins. **WOMANKIND** tells me that amount remains the highest total ever collected by a parish. Let's see if we can beat our own record!

Thank you to **St Charles Pro-Life Group** for arranging the details and thank you to our St Charles K of C Council for helping with next week's bottle distribution.

I remember the election of 1960. Some argued that if John Kennedy were elected, the Pope would come with him to the White House. How things have changed! In 2015, only fifty-five years later, Pope Francis is welcomed and invited to address Congress! Even non-Catholic politicians are vying to have a photo-op with him! How blessed we are with Pope Francis and his vision of the Church.

The Credit Union will continue to make a \$50 gift to St Charles Church or School (you choose which) for all auto loans made September 2015 through May 2016. 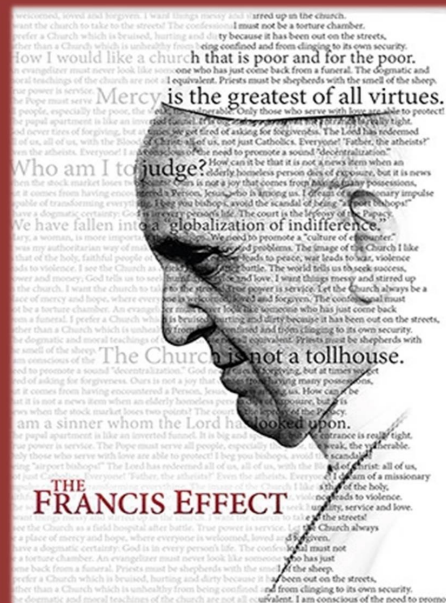
