

Here's a word of thanks to all who have taken such a lively interest in the planning and groundwork for our new Weekday/Weekend Mass Schedule. I have received lots of letters, notes, cards, e-mails, and comments with suggestions on how that new schedule should look. For three weekends, we counted the number of those who attend Mass at St Charles and at what times; we carefully checked the Cleveland Diocesan Directory for the Mass times in other parishes; we spent a good portion of our last Parish Council Meeting, Thursday, April 20, discussing the pros and cons. Where do we go from here? Well, this is the plan. On one weekend in May, we will ask for your vote in four areas:

Weekday Mass Time(s)
Saturday Afternoon/Evening Mass Time(s)
Sunday Morning Mass Times
Sunday Afternoon/Evening Mass Time

When those "ballots" are returned and reviewed, we will publicize the final results. We will advertise the proposed times for several weeks. The new schedule will go into effect by mid-June or the first weekend of July. In the meantime, as Lawrence Welk (remember him?) used to say: "Keep those cards and letters coming!"

St Charles parishioner, **Kevin Albertino**, a junior at St Ignatius High School, will devote a good portion of this summer 2017 to working in the Catholic missions of Moshi and Dodoma in Tanzania, Africa. Next Sunday, April 30, is First Communion Day at St Charles. First Communion Masses are scheduled for 12:00Noon and 2:30pm. Congratulations to our First Communicants and thank you to those in our Day School and PCRF programs for all your good work in preparing our second graders for this joyous day.

For those of us who made First Communion some time back, this is a good opportunity to review our practice of how we prepare to, and receive, the Eucharist.

It is your choice to receive on the tongue or in the hand. When the minister holds up the host and says "Body of Christ," the communicant says, with meaning and conviction, "Amen." Extend your tongue or make sure one hand is beneath the other, palms up. Receive the host and step to the side, consume the host. Return to your pew and make a proper thanksgiving. It is disrespectful, in fact irreverent, to just "walk out the door." Some folks could do much better; let's remember what we receive and be grateful for it.

Last, and not least, next Sunday, April 30, is a Fifth Sunday of the month. There will be a second collection at Mass next weekend for the St Vincent de Paul Society of St Charles Borromeo Parish.


