House Bill 200, sponsored by Representative Koehler, is the companion bill in the House to Senate Bill 85 (which creates the Ohio Opportunity Scholarship, which combines the Cleveland, EdChoice and Income-Based scholarship programs into one statewide scholarship program).

What you can do to help pass Senate Bill 85 & House Bill 200:

- Call & Email your legislators to tell them why you support the Opportunity Scholarship.
- Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper indicating your support of SB 85 & HB 200. Include your own story of how scholarships help you or families in your community.
