Dear St Charles Borromeo Parishioner:

This is the "My Fair Share" mailing for 2018; this is your opportunity to renew your membership in our parish. From time-to-time, we renew our driver's license, we re-subscribe to magazines, and we confirm our membership in various organizations. "Belonging to a parish" is also an important matter and we should make a conscious decision annually if we plan to remain a registered member.

In 2003, our pastor, our Parish Council, and our Parish Finance Council invited parishioners to attend one of forty-five Town Hall meetings. Thousands of parishioners met and, together, we designed the "My Fair Share" approach to parish membership and support. In subsequent years, various suggestions and comments have been offered and implemented. In short, parishioners said—loud and clear—"those who ask to be members of St Charles are expected to help with the work the parish does and each one should do 'a fair share." So parishioners are expected to share generously their "time, talent, and treasure."

If you wish to renew your parish membership for 2018, please complete the enclosed "My Fair Share 2018" form and return it to the Parish Office. To help our Finance Council budget for the upcoming year, please indicate how much you hope to donate to the parish in 2018; this is not a "binding pledge." Also, please select how you would like to offer that support: traditional weekly envelopes, a monthly envelope, or a quarterly or an annual payment. An increasing number of parishioners pay by credit card or by automatic withdrawal. If you choose one of those options, indicate that on the enclosed form and our Business Office will arrange the details with you.

A complete accounting of parish receipts and expenditures is offered annually, by way of the parish bulletin, on the weekend after Labor Day.

In addition to sharing the "treasure" of your financial support, parishioners are also asked to share their "time and talent" by volunteering to help with the ministries of worship, service, or education.

So that we can accomplish our work in a timely manner, you are asked to return the completed "My Fair Share 2018" form by Tuesday, October 31.
