

A few months back I mentioned in this column that St Charles Parish would soon welcome three members of the Evangelizing Sisters of Mary. They would reside in the 6818 Charles Avenue Convent; their full-time ministry will be as nurses at the Regina Health Care facility in Richfield. They will also be involved, as able, in St Charles Parish activities. The good Sisters will meet the operating expenses of their new home—with no cost to the parish.

We have been working to "make this happen." Immigration issues are handled very slowly and carefully by the officials in Washington, given international tensions. We had to prove that there is a proper residence for the Sisters and that there is gainful employment waiting for them. That has been done and we are looking forward to final disposition of their paperwork and we hope we will soon welcome the Sisters to St Charles. A few years back, St Charles parishioners were very helpful and generous in getting the first group of the Evangelizing Sisters settled at St Adalbert Parish on Cleveland's East Side; their convent was revamped and equipped by us.

St Charles Knights of Columbus have offered to help "equip" the Sisters who are coming here. Next Sunday, February 4, after the 8:00 and 10:00am Masses, the K of C will offer a Pancake Breakfast in the Lower Hall. Proceeds from that Breakfast will provide necessities for the 6818 Charles Convent: sheets, pillowcases, blankets, kitchen utensils, etc. for the soon-to-arrive Sisters. Plan on having breakfast here next Sunday—it's for a good cause! We now enjoy an hour between Masses, so you can have Breakfast and still exit the parking lot before the next Mass.

Congratulations to long-time St Charles parishioner Russell Fischer; Russ was honored last Sunday with the Diocesan CYO Recognition Award for his 27 years of work with our Track & Field and Cross Country teams. Russ has also served as our site director for volleyball and basketball. It was a well-deserved honor for his years of dedication. Also honored, posthumously, was Joseph Jira, St Charles football and basketball coach, 1937 to 1978. Joe was inducted into the CYO Hall of Fame. I was privileged to attend the ceremony honoring Russ and in memory



On the 2nd of February, forty days after Christmas, we come to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. On this day, we celebrate when Jesus was presented to the Temple in Jerusalem to consecrate Him to the Lord as prescribed in the Law of Moses. It is at this time that the light of the world, Christ Jesus, was brought into the Temple of the LORD for the first time. 




