It is almost time!! I'm sure many of our young children are as



anxious for CLW to return, just as our teachers are. Children's Liturgy returns on Sunday, September 8th at the 10:00am Mass. This program is for pre-school age children as well as those that have not received Holy Communion yet, essentially grades PreK-2.

This Thursday August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption and a holyday of obligation. For your convenience and service, there will be a Vigil Mass on Wednesday, August 14, at 7:00pm. On the Thursday, August 15, holyday Masses are scheduled for 7:00am, 10:00am, and at 7:00pm.

Father Lou Thomas, Deacon Dan Galla, and the RCIA team have put together the details for this year's RCIA program. RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. For the last forty years, RCIA is the preferred way to introduce adults to the Catholic Faith. In prior years, adults who joined the Church attended a "Convert Class" or received individual instructions from a parish priest.

St Charles **RCIA** sessions are held on Monday evenings in the John Paul II Room (second floor) of the Parish Activity Center. Sessions begin in mid-September, last about ninety minutes per evening, and conclude on Holy Saturday in the spring.

Over the year, the beliefs and practices of the Catholic Church are shared and explained. A "team" approach is used and all members of the pastoral staff help out.

RCIA is for those who are not baptized, or for those baptized in another Christian faith, or for those baptized Catholic but who have not received the Sacraments of Reconciliation or First Eucharist.

No final commitment is expected up front; attend a few sessions and see if **RCIA** is for you.

The **new school year** at St Charles begins in ten days, Wednesday, August 21, to be exact. You will find plenty of information, in this bulletin, about parent meetings and lots of other details. We are still taking phone calls about availability. Fifth grade is full, but we do have a few spaces in pre-school, kindergarten, and in grades one to four and six. Call the School Office for more info: 440-886-5546.

St Charles School faculty also staffs our Parish Catholic Religious Formation (PCRF) Programs that educate in our faith St Charles children who attend public and charter schools. Classes begin in mid-September for grades one through eight. Seventh and eighth graders may also choose a Monday evening program.

Children with Developmental needs attend our Special Education Program on Wednesday evenings.

Children who have not received the Sacraments appropriate to their age (Baptism, First Eucharist, and Reconciliation) are brought up-to-date in our Sacraments Out of Sequence Program.

Children's Liturgy of the Word (for ages four to First Communion age) resumes at the 10:00am Sunday Mass in mid-September. Children receive a Scripture lesson, appropriate to their age, from a trained catechist, during the Liturgy of the Word; children return to their parents for the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

2019 FIRST STEP PROGRAM

CONTINUING EDUCATION REGARDING MARRIAGE AND DIVORCE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Attempting to pick up the pieces of one's life after the tragedy of divorce is an area that can impact a person's relationship with God and the Church. One of the significant issues that a person faces is their place in the Church. Does the Church still care about me even though I am divorced? Am I allowed to go to Mass? Can I receive communion? How can the Church help me heal? If I decide to marry again, what do I have to do?



PRESCHOOL: Parents/guardians will receive a letter in the mail detailing their special schedule for the opening of preschool classes. Preschool will be phased-in during the week of September 4, with parents/guardians joining their children to learn more about the preschool program.

KINDERGARTEN: Parents/guardians will receive a letter detailing a special schedule for the opening of kindergarten classes. We call it "staggered entrance" on August 21 – parents come to school with their kindergarten child for a scheduled time to hear information in a small group setting about the kindergarten year. The first full day of kindergarten will be August 22.

GRADES 1-8: Students are to report for school on Wednesday, August 21 beginning at 7:45AM. Students should be in their school uniform and report to the designated place for their grade level. ALL STUDENTS MUST PACK A LUNCH AND DRINK ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL. Hot lunch will be served beginning August 22. Many thanks to Mrs. Bennett and her crew!

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: School supply lists are posted on our school website.
