Today, as a church, we celebrate the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time. As a nation, this is our **annual day to honor Fathers**. All Dads, living and deceased, will be remembered at Mass this weekend. Honor your dad by enrolling him in our **Fathers' Confraternity**. All member Dads will be remembered in a monthly Mass. Just stop by the Parish Office after Mass.

**Father Timothy Roth**, a priest-son of St. Charles Parish ordained in 2014, was assigned to study canon law in Rome last year. Father Roth is home for the summer and I have asked him to "lend a hand" here at St. Charles for the next few weeks until our newly ordained parochial vicar, Joshua Cochrac, arrives in August. Father Roth is able to help with weekday and weekend Masses, both public and livestreamed. That will be a great help to Father Chris and to me. **Welcome home and thank you, Father Tim Roth!**

Speaking of livestreaming, we will continue to offer a livestreamed Mass every day at 11:00am. Work is progressing on installing the necessary equipment in our church so that livestreaming can take place from there. We are hoping that the project will be completed within a month or so.

For as long as I can remember, each year's **eighth grade graduating class** has given an **Appreciation Gift** for use in our church. This year's class was most generous and donated \$1,600 toward our "church livestreaming" project. Several other parishioners have also been most generous toward "the cause." Many thanks to all!

Parish groups and organizations are gradually returning to life. All are most welcome to meet again on parish property. You are asked to observe the CDC health guidelines: wear masks and maintain a six-foot distance from each other. Check with the Parish Office for available facilities and open times.

We now have **six Plexiglass Communion stations** in our church to offer additional protection. You are asked to approach the station, place your hands, palms up, beneath the shield. Step to the side, lower your mask, and consume the host. During this time of Coronavirus, for the common good of all, Communion will only be distributed in the hand. When the pandemic is over, we will again offer Communion on the tongue for those who prefer it. Thank you for your kind understanding and cooperation. By the way, I attended a funeral at a nearby parish and saw similar stations there. The pastor told me he had seen a picture of ours on social media and had imitations of ours built for their parish!

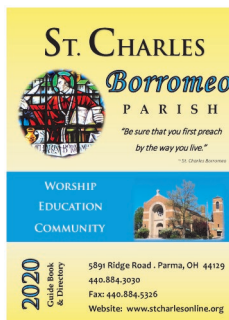
