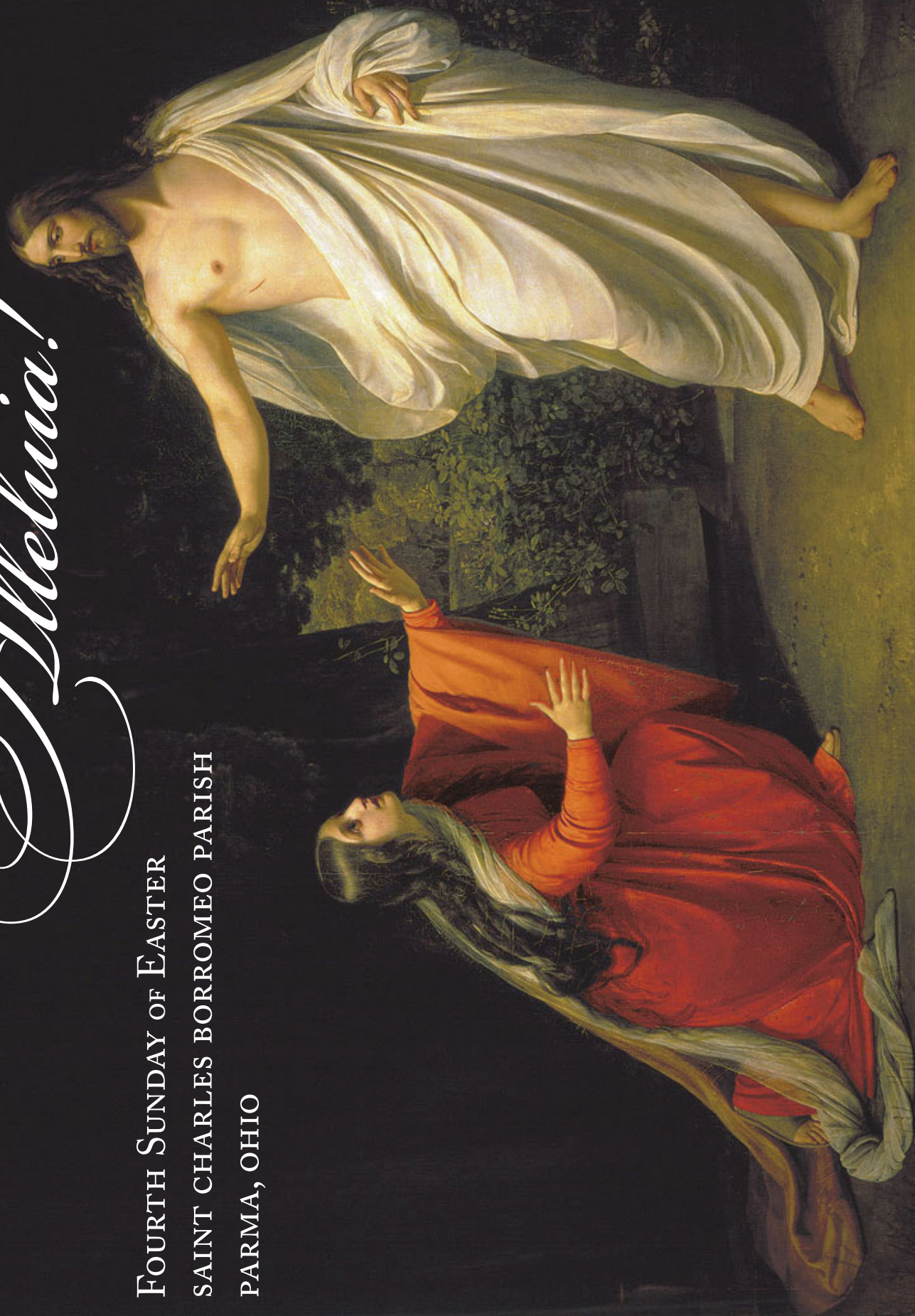

Here we are, already at the last week-end of April. This is the **Fourth Sunday of Easter**, also known as **Good Shepherd Sunday**.

I received an interesting, unexpected, but very welcome call from the Clergy Personnel Director last Wednesday. I was informed that Bishop Malesic is assigning an additional parochial vicar (old-fashioned term: "associate pastor") to St Charles effective this June. We will welcome **Father Anthony J Simone** to the pastoral staff. Father Simone was ordained a priest in 2017 and he has served faithfully and honorably at St Sebastian Parish in Akron for the last four years. Father Simone tells me he will be "most happy" to join us two months from now. Details to follow...

In last week's letter, I shared a lot of thoughts about our upcoming **One Hundredth Parish Anniversary, April 2022 to April 2023**. Here are a couple of additional mentions:

Last Saturday I attended the deacon ordination of lifelong parishioner Ian Kelly, son of Michelle and the late Dave Kelly. Ian will spend the next year, serving as a deacon, at St Ambrose Parish in Brunswick. We expect that Deacon Ian will be ordained a priest and celebrate his First Mass at St Charles as we begin our anniversary celebration in 2022. Our year-long anniversary celebration will conclude in 2023 as we celebrate the priesthood ordination and First Mass of parishioner Jeffrey Liptak.

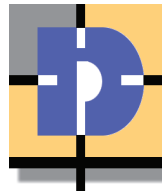
