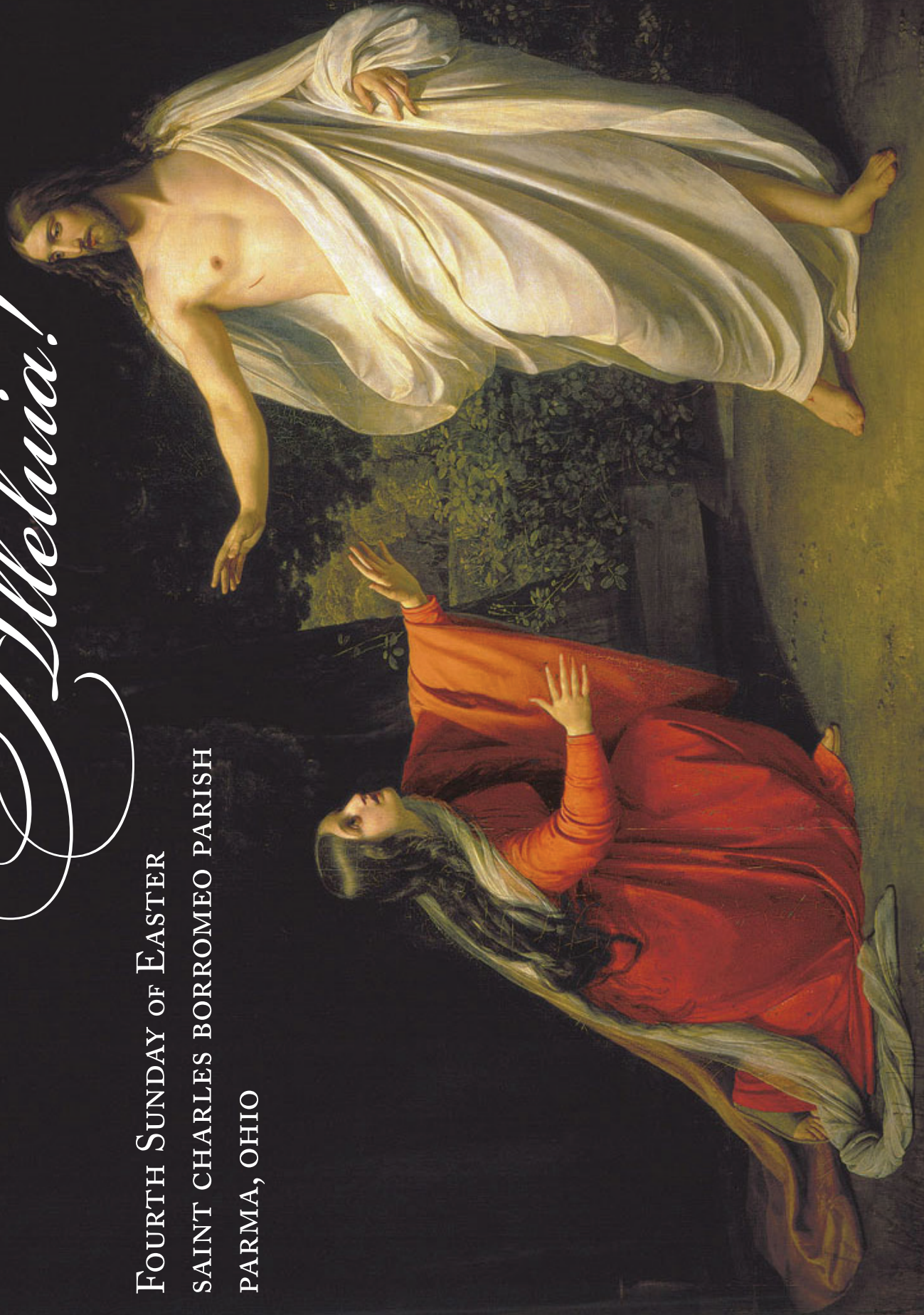

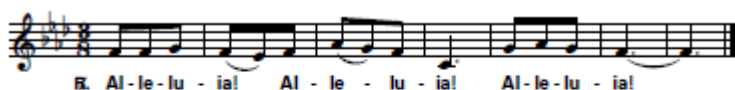

A very involved St. Charles family made a generous gift to the parish for our 100th Anniversary. 50TH WEDDING JUBILEE CELEBRATION

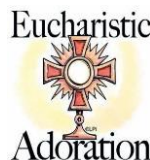
Saturday, June 25, 10:00am

Fr. Anthony's Word of the Week

Praying the Rosary is a dynamic thing. It's the same prayers and the same Mysteries like clockwork, but it's also never the same because it's prayer. As we know, we are not praying to Mary. We are asking Her to pray for us and we are praying with Her. I also like to describe the Rosary as resting with Mary...resting with Our Mother. If we pray the Rosary and we're not feeling any "bells and whistles" go off, it's ok. However, if we pray these prayers fervently and intentionally, rather than rushing through them, we can encounter God's grace in intimate and personal ways. Three ways come to mind, how I've experienced His grace through Her Rosary.

When I found my own personal relationship with Mary as Mother, I began to enter into the scenes of those mysteries, as if I were there. This is literally a wonderful way to encounter the Rosary. When I ponder the Mysteries, I'll gravitate towards my favorite glimpses with Jesus and Mary over and over again. Sometimes, my mind will gravitate towards details or surroundings that hadn't occurred to me before. (Which is always a gift.) Another way I've experienced the Rosary is simply rest, comfort and protection. These prayers center me before I walk out the door, calm me when I'm anxious, or help me find rest before I head to bed. Praying with those beads in your hand is a place of refuge, like a child holding their mother's hand. Mary simultaneously comforts us and forces the enemy away from us. Something else I'm noticing lately are the side-thoughts you have while you're praying the rosary. Sometimes we're just distracted but distractions aren't always an accident. When you take your hands off the steering wheel in prayer, the Holy Spirit can steer more. I'll be reminded about something I need to do, something I still need to do, or something I forgot to do. So after I'm done praying, I write it down so I won't forget again. I don't know about you, but I've found mothers are good at reminding us! This makes the most sense with Mary because after she gave God Her *Fiat*, She became espoused to the Holy Spirit in order to bring the Son of God into the world. Now for us, Her guidance is intertwined with the guidance of the Holy Spirit. How can we not trust or go to such a Mother? Happy Mother's Day! Let's give thanks that our mother is beloved to Mary, like us, as a Mother.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA STATUE

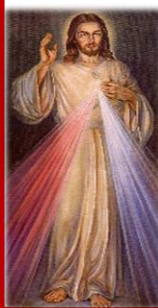

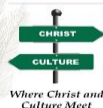

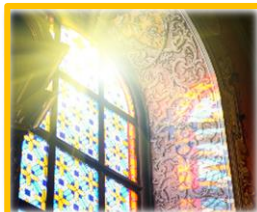

SACRED HEART
COUNSELING

A REFLECTION FROM LUKE BROWN, LPCC

Despite mental health issues becoming more problematic and widespread throughout the world, there is still a stigma surrounding counseling. I have had a great number of clients who come to counseling and say that their spouses, families, and friends have no idea that they are there and that they would like to keep it that way. It is interesting to me that someone could reach out for help to make their life better rather than turning to drugs, alcohol, or reckless behavior to get rid of the pain, and their social sphere would rather criticize and ridicule than affirm and encourage them.

Mental health issues are similar to other problems in life in that we need to seek help when we are in pain. If your best friend was diagnosed with lung cancer, would you shame them for going to the doctor and not being strong enough to handle it on their own? Would you tell them, "Try harder!" What about, "If you just changed your attitude this would go away." These are exact words I've heard said to people struggling with severe depression. We need to make a better effort to encourage those that struggle, even ourselves, to seek out mental health services. Seeking out counseling is not a sign that a person's faith is not strong enough, prayer too infrequent, or character too weak. Please, if someone you know is seeking or already in counseling, support them. Encourage them. Most of all, pray for them.
