

At this Sunday's 10:00am Mass, the celebration of the Third Scrutiny, which welcomes God's presence into the lives of the OCIA Elect, emphasizes Jesus as "the Resurrection and the Life" as we hear in the Gospel of the raising to life of Lazarus.

This is the **Fifth Sunday of Lent**. It is the last Sunday during this Lent for Confessions after Sunday Masses, due to next weekend's Palm Sunday lengthy reading of the Passion.

This Saturday evening, April 5, we welcome Cleveland Bishop Edward Malesic. The Bishop was last here in April of 2023 to celebrate our parish's one-hundredth anniversary. Welcome back, Bishop!

The Bishop joins us this Saturday to confirm the Class of 2025. The Confirmation Mass is scheduled for 6:30pm. Due to the tight schedule, the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confessions) cannot be offered AFTER Mass just this Saturday.

St. Charles Youth Group teens have been reflecting and praying upon the **Stations of the Cross** during this Lent. On **Palm Sunday, April 13, at 7:00pm** in church, our teens will offer a short prayer service. The teens will share their reflection and a prayer for each of the Fourteen Stations. All friends and parishioners are welcome and encouraged to attend. What a perfect way to begin Holy Week!

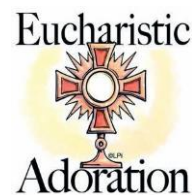

## SACRED HEART COUNSELING



### A REFLECTION FROM LUKE BROWN, LPCC


In this week's Gospel, we get to see the humanity of Jesus as He suffers with difficult feelings related to the death of Lazarus. A priest once told me that the humanity of Jesus could be captured best in the phrase, "Jesus wept." The longer that I am a counselor, the more that the priest's insight rings true for me. Often, I hear clients say that they should not be experiencing difficult feelings or they should just "get over it." When I ask about this further, they often say that they know that they should trust in God more and that they should know that it is all part of His plan. Also, they often feel guilty because they interpret their difficult feelings as an indication that they do not trust or love God enough. However, today's Gospel shows Jesus, who is perfect in every way, weeping at the loss of a loved one. While difficult feelings are painful and involve suffering, it does not mean that there is anything wrong with the feelings or the fact that we are having them. Jesus does not rebuke us or condemn us for having these feelings! He wants us to bring these feelings to Him and rest in Him. Difficult feelings are difficult enough by themselves. We only make it worse when we heap condemnation on ourselves for having the feelings in the first place. If you are struggling with difficult feelings and are worried about God's judgment, consider reflecting on today's Gospel as a source of inspiration and encouragement to rest in Him.

## Seven Churches Pilgrimage

The Seven Churches Visitation, a Holy Thursday tradition, involves Catholics visiting seven churches to reflect on Jesus' journey from the Last Supper to His crucifixion, praying at altars of repose and meditating on specific events. The tradition is believed to have originated in Rome with St. Philip Neri in the 1500s, where he would lead groups to visit the seven Basilicas on Holy Thursday night. The pilgrimage is a way to "keep watch" with Christ, as the apostles did in the Garden of Gethsemane, and to reflect on the events leading to His crucifixion.

Each church visit corresponds to a specific location or event in Jesus' final journey.
