


A REFLECTION FROM LUKE BROWN, LPCC

In this week's Gospel, we get to see the humanity of Jesus as He suffers with difficult feelings related to the death of Lazarus. A priest once told me that the humanity of Jesus could be captured best in the phrase, "Jesus wept." The longer that I am a counselor, the more that the priest's insight rings true for me. Often, I hear clients say that they should not be experiencing difficult feelings or they should just "get over it." When I ask about this further, they often say that they know that they should trust in God more and that they should know that it is all part of His plan. Also, they often feel guilty because they interpret their difficult feelings as an indication that they do not trust or love God enough. However, today's Gospel shows Jesus, who is perfect in every way, weeping at the loss of a loved one. While difficult feelings are painful and involve suffering, it does not mean that there is anything wrong with the feelings or the fact that we are having them. Jesus does not rebuke us or condemn us for having these feelings! He wants us to bring these feelings to Him and rest in Him. Difficult feelings are difficult enough by themselves. We only make it worse when we heap condemnation on ourselves for having the feelings in the first place. If you are struggling with difficult feelings and are worried about God's judgment, consider reflecting on today's Gospel as a source of inspiration and encouragement to rest in Him.






