

Be merciful, O Lord, for we have sinned.

Every Saint has a feast day (*usually the day that they died*), but not every Saint is celebrated on the liturgical calendar, meaning not every Saint is remembered on their feast day when the Church gathers to celebrate Mass or the Liturgy of the Hours. We find a good illustration of this on February 14th. Liturgically, it is the feast of Saints Cyril and Methodius, but most people on that day seem to celebrate Saint Valentine's Day – a man who was celebrated on the liturgical calendar prior to 1969, but whose feast day was replaced when the calendar was reformed.

So, who was Saint Valentine, and why is he associated with love? As with many of the early Roman martyrs, a complete biography is not possible. However, we do know that Valentine was born into the Roman Empire (*in modern-day Italy*) in the Third Century. He was the Bishop of Terni and lived during the persecution of Emperor Claudius II (*also known as Claudius the Cruel*). In order to recruit and retain men for the Imperial army, Claudius forbade his soldiers, along with other young men in Rome, from marrying. This way, they had nothing to distract them from military service or to prevent them from enlisting in the army. Bishop Valentine, however, refused to abide by the emperor's edict and began to marry soldiers and young lovers in secret. When it was discovered what Saint Valentine was doing and that he was a Christian, he was arrested, beaten, and then beheaded around AD 270.

Aside from the fact that he was marrying young lovers, even though it was against the law, there are a variety of historical traditions on how this saint became associated with our modern-day Valentine's traditions. One such account speaks of the saint converting the jailer and his family to the Christian faith while he awaited execution. As his execution drew near, he left a note for the jailer's daughter who had become his friend, and signed it – “from your Valentine.” Another tradition speaks of the Roman custom of young men drawing the name of a young woman out of a box on the feast of Lupercalia (*a pagan festival of love taking place on February 15th*), with whom they would couple off for the upcoming year. In response to this, the Church replaced it by inviting people to celebrate the feast of Saint Valentine, and instead of drawing a young woman's name out of a box, they would draw the name of a Saint whom they were supposed to strive to imitate. Finally, during the Middle Ages, it was believed that birds chose their mates around the middle of the month of February, and for this reason, Valentine's feast day became associated with love, which people commemorated by expressing their affections and sending small tokens to their beloved.

Despite the highly commercialized and often very sentimental way that our society celebrates this Saint's feast day, the man himself gives us an authentic portrayal of what real love looks like. While feelings may accompany genuine love, love is not a feeling. It is an act of the will, a choice – that one makes to imitate divine love – meaning – a willingness, like Christ, to lay down one's life for the sake of their beloved; to do everything in one's power, spending oneself completely in the service of the good of the other, not expecting anything in return. That's hard, and for us it is impossible, but for God all things are possible. We need the help of God's grace. It was grace that allowed Valentine to heroically witness his love for Christ by the shedding of his blood, and it is only by God's grace that we are able to love as we ought. Every year on Saint Valentine's feast day, hundreds of couples travel to his tomb to pledge their love for one another and ask Valentine's help, so that they will truly be able to love each other. If your relationship with your spouse, family, or other loved ones is not where you'd like it to be, say a prayer to Saint Valentine this February 14th. Ask him to pray for you, that, like him, you might be able to cooperate with God's grace and truly love, as God calls us and helps us to love.



SACRED HEART
COUNSELING

In this weekend’s Gospel, Jesus teaches us that we are the salt of the earth and the light of the world. I find this passage to be encouraging, fulfilling, and hopeful. I have found it especially encouraging for times in my life when I thought my job, status in life, or presence were not “holy” enough to bring anyone closer to Christ, or I was in a place of discouragement where I did not see much meaning in my life. I think of the time I was a tractor mechanic and thought my job was not so meaningful. In hindsight, making sure tractors get their oil changed ensures that farmers and ranchers can do their important work of feeding the country! My point is this – whatever job we have, age we are, or status we hold, we can influence the world around us for better or for worse. We might think that our position at work is lowly and insignificant, or that our age is a barrier and we think we have nothing to offer, but this Gospel passage illustrates that it is the opposite with Christ. It is tempting to get discouraged and be self-critical when we think our lives have no meaning, but there is so much meaning to find if we know where to look. We learn in the Gospel this week that if your heart is still beating, you are valued in this world and that God wants to use you to build His Kingdom.
