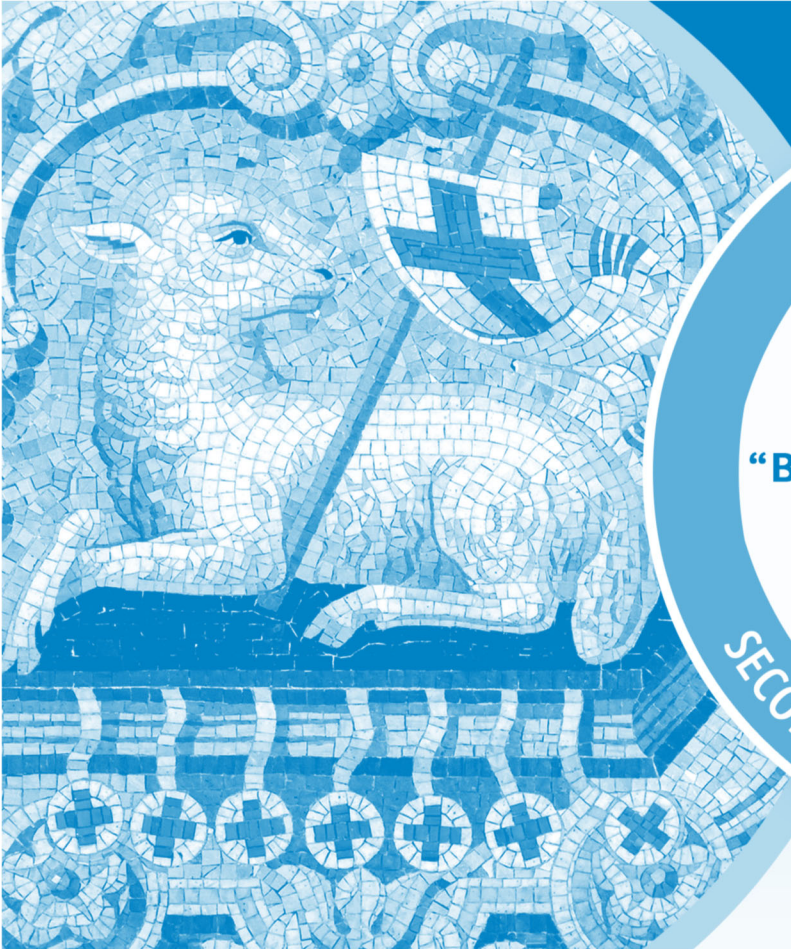

Today at the 10:00 & 1:00 Masses, we celebrated one of the rituals that accompany Christian initiation: the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. Carrie Biely, Fernando Lua, Rachal McCutchen, Wayne Tidwell, Jorge Luis Cazales and Samantha Olguin came to us some months ago, inquiring about Jesus and about how we, who are Roman Catholics, follow him. They have been among us, seen Christ's power, and have begun to be influenced by His grace. His grace led them to today, where we had the privilege of accepting them, embracing them, and formally beginning what will be a lifelong relationship with Christ and the Church. Today, they embraced the cross, and accepted the Sacred Scriptures. Today, they became known to us as catechumens. From this day on, until they complete their preparation and are called to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, we will walk with them, sharing our liturgies, our Tradition, our works of charity and justice, and our life in community. EN PREPARACIÓN PARA LA FIESTA DE DON BOSCO (31 DE ENERO) – PARTE 2

“MI PAPÁ NO ME QUIERE”

A veces los padres están tan dedicados al trabajo que, cuando vuelven al hogar, llegan cansados y hasta mal humorados. El cansancio influye en la manera, tal vez poco amable, con que tratan a sus hijos. La conclusión de la hija es: “no me quiere”. Tal vez por ello Don Bosco, cuando explica su sistema educativo al que llamó “Preventivo” asegura que “no basta amar, ellos y ellas tienen que darse cuenta que tú, mamá o papá, los amas”.

Más aún, para el fundador de los salesianos mientras más cariñosa y confiable es la relación, más grande es la confianza del que aprende con respecto a lo que se ha aprendido. Basta que recurramos a nuestra propia experiencia para reconocer lo importante que es la bondad del cariño en educación: las cosas que aprendemos de las personas que amamos tienen un mayor impacto en nuestra vida y son más difíciles de olvidar que lo que aprendemos de otros. Por el contrario, cuando el trato es distante, mal humorado o de cansancio, los niños y jóvenes actúan para complacer a quien temen. Se convierten en personas sin autenticidad y aprenden el arte de las máscaras.

Don Bosco ofrece tres claves para establecer una buena relación padre/madre-hijo/hija

“Amar lo que el joven ama, para que puedan amar lo que nosotros amamos”.

“No es suficiente amar, deben darse cuenta que son amados”.

“La familiaridad alimenta el afecto. El afecto alimenta la confianza”

Algunas habilidades que sirven para establecer una relación genuina, una verdadera ecología del amor tierno:

- Escuchar para acoger la opinión de los niños, niñas y adolescentes

Dedicándoles tiempo y tomando en cuenta sus opiniones en las cosas que les afectan se animan a ser ellos mismos y a expresarse sin usar máscaras al tiempo que hacen propuestas para mejorar las cosas.

- Estar disponible

El amor se manifiesta en la presencia física de los padres y educadores entre sus hijos y no en discursos floridos o regalos caros.

- Conocer y saber usar las propias emociones

Conocer los propios sentimientos, saber expresarlos y poder controlarlos. También conocer los sentimientos de los demás y ayudarles a controlarlos cuando sea necesario.

¿Qué otras habilidades añadirías tú? Por último, algunas formas en que los padres y madres dan calidez a sus hijos (as): divirtiéndose con ellos, diciéndoles “te quiero”, demostrándoles que confían en ellos, mostrándoles que son amados, aunque hagan algo mal, reconociendo sus esfuerzos y éxitos, leyéndoles historias (a los más pequeños), estimulándolos cuando enfrenten retos difíciles, reconfortándolos cuando estén heridos o tengan miedo...

Revisar cómo lo estamos haciendo y ajustar lo que sea necesario, será un buen regalo para Don Bosco que, al igual que Jesús, “pasó por este mundo haciendo el bien” a los jóvenes más pobres y en peligro.

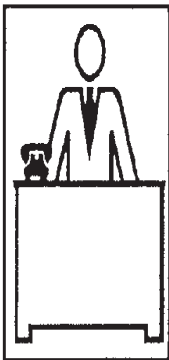
