2 | A Word from Our Pastor



Last week I shared with you information from the Archdiocese's All Things New pastoral planning initiative. It was data about the vitality, strengths and challenges of parishes in the mid-county section of St. Louis which includes St. Peter. Today I provide some analysis that has been given about our parish.

First, some historical facts about St. Peter are noteworthy. We are the second oldest parish in St. Louis County having been established in 1832. (St. Ferdinand in Florissant was founded in 1788.) St. Peter is the mother church of several parishes in the region that have been carved out of its original boundaries. We have a rich association with the City of Kirkwood and unique for having

Coyle parish high school in the 1940s and 1950s. When it closed in 1960 it led to the Marianist order opening Vianney High School and the Ursuline Sisters expanding nearby Ursuline Academy.

While our parish is land locked, there has been growth in population due to construction of condos, apartments, and "tear downs" of small houses to build large family homes. Though much of the historic African-American Meacham Park area was replaced with commercial development, the parish area has still maintained a stable racial/ethnic minority of about 15%. Median household income is \$84,500, which is well above the Archdiocesan average of \$60,700. 29% of the resident population of our area is Catholic – well above the Archdiocesan average of 18%.


Looking at the scatter dot map on the next page, the red dots are parishioner households. Blue dots are Catholic households that are registered at a different parish. There are many more parishioner households (2121) than there are Catholic households in the boundaries (1835). This means that many more Catholic households come into the parish from outside the boundaries than leave the parish area to affiliate elsewhere. As the red dots (parishioners) show on the map, the parish draws Catholics from all over the neighboring area.

Here are some other facts that All Things New tells us about St. Peter Church.

- St. Peter is the 12th largest parish in the Archdiocese with 2,200 households and growing.
- We have the 4th largest elementary school in the Archdiocese with 529 (Pre-K to 8) students and the 4th largest PSR.
- Membership has been increasing during the past decade primarily drawing parishioners from outside the boundaries.
- Baptisms at St. Peter are strong, among the most in the diocese, rivaling the big parishes of St. Charles County.
- 79% of our day school graduates go on to attend Catholic high schools.
- Offertory giving at St. Peter has been steady over the last decade, averaging about \$1.7 million each year.

Like other parishes in the Archdiocese, St. Peter is experiencing significant decline in Sunday Mass attendance. Prior to the COVID pandemic, the church attendance rate at St. Peter was between 23-27%, below the Archdiocesan rate of 27-29%.

The All Things New analysis identified other challenges St. Peter faces. It noted that the parish investment in the school has been much higher than the 20-30% subsidy generally recommended for a school's ordinary operating budget. And while St. Peter parishioners are generous in their giving, we have had difficulty generating sufficient revenue to grow our financial reserves.





What can you expect from the All Things New process in the months ahead? A survey will be sent soliciting your input as to where St. Peter should invest its greatest attention to succeed in the areas of evangelization and social outreach. In late August potential models for new configurations of parishes and schools will be shared with the priests of the Archdiocese. In the fall, each parish will host two in-person listening sessions at which further data and feedback will be provided and proposed parish and school models for each planning area will be shared.



# A MESSAGE FROM FR. O'TOOLE



The parish family of St. Peter is like any household: it has practical needs that require attention so that daily life can carry on productively. As a parishioner, you are part of the home ownership of the facilities we all use. Our church parking lot is one of them and I am sure you recognize the importance of keeping our grounds safe and efficient. The replacement of the church lot will begin soon – around June 27 and be completed in four weeks. Our Property and Buildings Committee has thoroughly studied the scope and cost of this project and the decision has been made that it is necessary to do this now before the scope of the project increases from the deferred maintance. I would like to extend my thanks and gratitude to the Property and Buildings Committee. Their diligence in protecting and maintaining


the faciliites on our campus has been outstanding.

This project comes with a rather hefty price tag of about \$267,000 which includes a contingency. We have a good start on funding as several organizations of St. Peter have generously given from their funds to meet more than half the cost. Now I invite you to be a part of this effort to meet the remaining balance of approximately \$100,000. If you are able, please make a one-time contribution. Any amount is greatly appreciated and will be counted as part of your offertory giving. I also want to let you know that as of this writing, we are in the final stage of a lease agreement with the City of Kirkwood to be remunerated for use of our lot by neighboring businesses, so that future parking lot maintenance will be supported in part by the funds from this agreement.

# **PROJECT COST**

\$267,298

The project scope and bidding was managed by PaveTech. A Request for Proposal was sent to four companies, after evaluation and leveling, bids ranged from \$249,225 to \$322,298. The project was awarded to Asphaltic Maintenance & Construction, the lowest bid which includes negotiated pricing for materials. We have added approximately 7% of the cost as a contingency, bringing our total cost of the project to \$267,560
