SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

In accordance with Archdiocesan policy, couples should contact a member of the parish clergy at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date to schedule your wedding date and for details regarding the preparation program.

I think it helps to refresh our memories and revisit some principles about our worship that we may have forgotten, as well as deal with a few things that may be awkward to address but should be said. These "pointers" are aimed at no persons in particular. They are simply gentle reminders that can enhance our experience of sacred worship and help clear up confusion about what is the best thing to do. I hope they help all of us.

Make Yourself Hungry to Receive Jesus

The Eucharistic fast is something that has been slipping the attention of many Catholics. The practice is meant to intensify our spiritual and physical hunger for the Lord at Mass. In earlier times, the faithful were not allowed to consume anything from midnight prior to receiving Holy Communion. Today, as the Code of Canon Law teaches, "A person who is to receive the Most Holy Eucharist is to abstain for at least one hour before Holy Communion from any food and drink, except for only water and medicine." (919.1) I would note that this hour of abstinence includes coffee, chewing gum and breath mints. (I've seen people finishing off their Starbuck's in the car before stepping into church!) All this may seem scrupulous, but I believe such discipline increases our awareness of how sacred reception of the Eucharist is. There are exceptions to this obligation for the elderly and the infirmed as well as those who care for them.

"St. Peter People Are Late with Everything"

That's a boast I've heard some parishioners make. I have lived in a number of parishes, however, and I don't know one where the same couldn't be said about their habits of punctuality. But it's not going to stop me from trying to encourage everyone to be prompt for church! So, for the record, weekend Masses at St. Peter begin at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, and 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. Remember, it's good to arrive a little early so you can practice stillness and have some time for contemplation with God. You deserve that.

Communion Etiquette

When receiving the Blessed Sacrament in the hand, the communicant should be guided by the words of St. Cyril of Jerusalem who wrote in the 4th century: "When you approach, take care not to do so with your hand stretched out and your fingers open or apart, but rather place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost." Remember, it's rude to grab. Nor should we be in a hurry to receive our Lord and move on. (This isn't fast food!) Reverence and carefulness will prevent the Eucharist from falling to the floor. And don't forget to make a reverent bow before receiving and to pronounce a strong, "Amen!" when hearing, "The Body of Christ."

Blessed Are the Little Ones

At the time of the Communion procession we are happy to extend a blessing to children who have not yet made their First Holy Communion. It is not always easy for the Eucharistic minister (or me) to know whether or not the Host should be offered when a child comes forward. To help amend this confusion, teach your little one to make a distinct gesture of arms crossed over his/her chest. Come closely to the minister of Communion and pause to receive the blessing. Adults who are not Catholic are asked to do the same if they choose to come forward.


