Solemnity of Pentecost 2023

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend the Church throughout the world celebrates the Solemnity of Pentecost, and so commemorates the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, the foundation of the Church, and the beginning of her mission to all nations and peoples.

The mystery of Pentecost exhorts us to prayer and commitment to mission. The Holy Spirit inspires faith, hope, and charity in the hearts of the faithful, and ennobles the numerous and varied ways of transmitting the Christian message according to the culture and customs of all times and places. While giving us access to communion with God in prayer, the Holy Spirit also prompts us towards service of our neighbor by encountering him, by reconciliation, by witness, by a desire for justice and peace, by renewal of outlook, by social progress, and missionary commitment.

Almost two years ago, we as an Archdiocese embarked upon a strategic pastoral planning process, *All Things New*. We prayed to the Holy Spirit for guidance, and we committed ourselves to you the faithful of this Archdiocese. An extensive process of listening was undertaken in all the parishes. Thereafter, I consulted the Archdiocesan Presbyteral Council regarding every parish under consideration. I then spent time in further prayer, study, and discernment, after which I reached the following decision regarding St. Peter (Kirkwood) parish.

Your parish will remain unchanged regarding its present structure and the Reverend Matthew O'Toole, who is presently assigned to provide pastoral care for your parish, will continue to do so, as well as the Reverend Charles Archer, as associate pastor. I invite you to express your gratitude to your priests for their dedicated service in your parish.

While there is no change to the structure of your parish, we are all called to rededicate ourselves to new modes of evangelization and social outreach. I ask that you join me in praying for those among the faithful of the Archdiocese who will be hearing other challenging news this weekend regarding their parish.

Please join me in praying that the Holy Spirit will draw us all closer together as we commit ourselves to following the Lord Jesus and spreading His message by the witness of our lives.







A VINCENTIAN RESPONSE TO UKRAINAIN REFUGEES



Following Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, over 200,000 Ukrainians sought refuge in the U.S., many settling in St. Louis, a city with a rich history of welcoming immigrants and refugees. Many of these Ukrainian refugees are now living

with host families, but with the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, they require permanent housing.

Depaul USA is initiating a \$200,000 capital campaign to purchase St. Michael's House, a duplex intended to provide supportive housing for Ukrainian refugee families. This facility will aid these families in their transition to U.S. life, offering connections to language classes, social services, job opportunities, and schools. The goal is to give families the time and space to amass the resources needed for independent living.

Depaul USA, which currently operates 65 units of housing for the chronically homeless and runs St. Lazare House, is partnering with the Sisters of Charity Housing Development Corporation for this project.
