On the failure to designate the location of the mosting place within the district, five electors may petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the "TCEQ") to designate a location. If the TCEO determines that the meeting place used by the district deprives the residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend district meetings, the TCEQ may designate a meeting place inside or outside the district which is reasonably available to the public and require that the meetings be held at such place. After the next election, the board may designate different meeting places, including one located outside the boundaries of the district.
