### **Meeting Topics:**

The meeting will be held for the following purposes:

1. Public Comment.
2. Consider and take action regarding approval of the minutes from the Board of Directors' March 12, 2026, meeting.
3. Consider and take action regarding District utility operations, maintenance and service matters:
  - a. Receive Operator's Report regarding monthly operations;
  - b. Approve Wastewater System and Drainage System Repairs and Maintenance; and
  - c. Approve action relating to customer billing and payment matters.
4. Consider and take action relating to contractor damage to District reclaimed water line.
5. Receive, consider and take action regarding construction of public infrastructure improvements serving the District:
  - a. Receive Engineer's Report Regarding Design and Construction of Public Infrastructure Improvements Serving the District;
  - b. Approve the award of contracts for construction of public infrastructure improvements;
  - c. Approve Construction Pay Estimates and Change Orders for public infrastructure improvements; and

- d. Approve final acceptance for Public Infrastructure Improvements serving the District.
6. Consider and take action regarding acceptance of conveyance of real property interests for District infrastructure improvements.
7. Consider and take action regarding approval of acceptance of easements, release of easements, and modification of easements associated with construction of Comal County Independent School District school within the District.
8. Consider and take action relating to request that the District convey an easement to SJWTX, Inc. (Texas Water Company) in and to District lands for waterline improvements that would serve lands outside the District.
9. Consider and take action relating to potential sale and issuance of Meyer Ranch Municipal Utility District Comal County Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2026 (the "Bonds"):
  - a. Receive Report from Financial Advisor regarding Underwriter Bids for Purchase of the Bonds;
  - b. Award the Sale of the Bonds;
  - c. Adopt Order Authorizing the Issuance of \$6,500,000 Meyer Ranch Municipal Utility District of Comal County Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2026; Prescribing the Terms and Provisions Thereof; Making Provision for the Payment of the Interest Thereon and the Principal Thereof, Levying and Pledging the Proceeds of a Tax Authorizing the Sale of the Bonds; Authorizing a Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement; and Containing Other Provisions Relating to the Subject;
  - d. Approve Payment of Attorney General filing fee; and
  - e. Authorize the District's Officers and Directors, Financial Advisor, General Counsel and Bond Counsel to take all actions necessary, appropriate or convenient in connection with the sale of the Bonds, including, without limitation, executing appropriate documents in connection therewith.
10. Discussion and possible action relating to cybersecurity training requirements applicable to public officials.
11. Receive Developer's Report regarding the status of development and sales activities within the District.
12. Consider and take action regarding Approval of Bookkeeper Report and Payment of Bills and Invoices.
