Our Second Collection this weekend is for Peter's Pence. This collection is for those areas of the world that are experiencing suffering and in need of assistance.

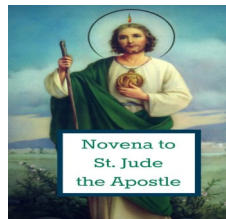
Farewell reception for Fr. Solomon will be today AFTER THE 9:30 MASS. PLEASE JOIN US.

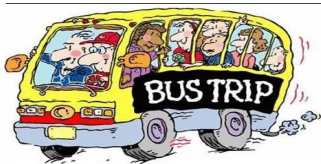
