The annual parish report was reviewed and explained. Charleen told us that the recurring users of WE Share are 244. The question came up as to if some of the Due to/Due From accounts could be cleared. As well as since the school is doing better financially if they could take over their old Fire Loan.

The July financials were reviewed. All are concerned going forward regarding offertory as we are seeing the numbers decreasing. Last year for July there was a request for funds letter, and we have further discussion regarding this in upcoming month. July is the first month of the fiscal year so little activity in certain departments.

Upcoming parish events include: a mystery dinner at St. Pat's on October 22, a Christmas fair at St. Charles and St. Mary's on November 6 and 13 respectively. The Tree Festival is on schedule. The new building is busy with rentals 5 nights a week starting in September.
