



PASTOR'S NOTE

August 27 ~ Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel is so familiar that it may be easy to just let Jesus' question go quickly by without taking the time to answer him - "Who do you say that I am?" Will you respond with the conviction of Peter — "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God"? Or do you struggle to say who Christ is or if you know him at all? This Gospel invites everyone to take a few minutes today to consider what answer we give and to urge us to give time for the relationship with Jesus to grow. Taking time to honestly answer Jesus' question, will lead to our ability to say like Peter — "You are the Christ!"


Dear parishioners,

In the context of salvation, holiness, and spiritual growth, besides and above their communal dimension, the personal dimension is crucial and even indispensable. Judgment, which is one of the "Four Last Things," is personal because we act personally using our free will and conscience. No doubt, then, that Jesus in today's gospel, besides and above what people thought of him, he turns towards his disciples, his friends and asks: "But who do you say that I am?" It matters a lot for Jesus to know what his followers think of him. This presupposes that it is not enough to be a disciple of Jesus by name; a disciple of Jesus should know who He is and act accordingly. The more we know someone, discover their qualities and strength, the more we will love them and be closer to them. The same is true with us Christians. If we really know who Jesus is, we will fall more and more in love with him and we would like to always be with him in his word and in the sacraments, especially in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. As a little examination of conscience, the following questions come to my mind: Would it be that my lack of commitment, my reluctance to spend time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, or lack of interest in the sacrament of reconciliation or lack of thirst for the Scriptures are a sign that my knowledge of Jesus is superficial? If I am to answer Jesus' question: "who do you think that I am," will I give ready-made answers I learned from the catechism or give an answer from the heart, an answer that comes from my personal relationship with Jesus in prayer and in the sacraments? Dear brethren, every day is an opportunity for us to know Jesus personally and deeply. The church offers us such opportunities as daily masses at 9:00 am, weekend masses, vespers and benediction every first Sunday of the month at 6:30 pm, a whole day adoration every Thursday ending with rosary and benediction and other spiritual events as announced. May we make use of those to increase our knowledge and love for Jesus.

As Summer is drawing to an end, we are preparing to kick off our Religious Education program. Registration forms for Religious Education/CCD (grades 1-12) are available at the back of the church and on our website under Faith Formation (www.stannesalem.org/faith-formation-registration). Classes will begin on Sunday, September 24th at 9:30 am. The week before, on Sunday, September 17th, committed volunteer teachers will meet to prepare for the first class. For any questions regarding CCD, please contact Louise Frederickson, our new Director of Religious Education, at the parish phone number or by email at religioused@stannesalem.org.

I wish to invite you to consider volunteering to help transmit the faith to young people. It is an opportunity not only to transmit Catholic doctrine and the faith but also of deepening your own knowledge of the Church's teaching and your faith.





SPECIAL COLLECTION FOR MAUI RELIEF September 2-3, 2023

The images and news reports coming out of the Island of Maui are heartbreaking. The wildfires have killed more than 100 people, left many injured and missing, and destroyed homes and businesses.

Pope Francis has expressed his solidarity with the people of Maui including all suffering from this tragedy, while also invoking God's blessing of "strength and peace."

Recognizing the immediate and growing need for assistance, Cardinal Seán has asked that a special collection be taken in all parishes in the Archdiocese of Boston to support Church relief efforts in the Diocese of Honolulu. Ste. Anne's will have a Special Collection on the weekend of September 2/3.

Funds raised will support the Hawaii Catholic Community Foundation (HCCF) relief efforts for local community members affected by the Maui wildfires.
