

PASTOR'S NOTE

November 26th ~ Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Today's parable is one of the most vivid parables Jesus spoke. We will not be judged on the knowledge we have accumulated, or the fame that we have acquired, or the fortune we have gained. We will be judged on the way we have listened and been present to others, and in the way we have served Christ in the other. The lesson is crystal clear - God will judge us according to our reaction to those in need. This means being willing to be present and helpful to the people we meet every day - to the hungry, the thirsty, the sick, the stranger, the prisoner — to Christ himself!

This weekend we celebrate the last Sunday of the year (Year A), Christ, King of the Universe. It was my hope that we end the church year with hitting our goal of 100 families making their commitment and returning their Grateful Discipleship forms and begin a new year (Year B) with increased participation at activities and improved weekend collection. We have not reached our goal yet, but I am pleased to report that so far 32 families have returned their commitment forms. 



SIMBANG GABI 2023: A Revered Filipino Christmas Tradition

Simbang Gabi, which means "Night Mass or Evening Mass," is a novena, a devotional 9-day series of Masses attended by Filipino Catholics in anticipation of Christmas and to honor the Blessed Mother. It culminates on Christmas Eve with the midnight Mass.





Infant Jesus in the womb of our Lady leading up to Christmas, and so, we join or accompany her, so to speak, as she awaits the birth of her Son. For this reason, the Masses on these days are celebrated as solemn votive Masses in her honor.

The celebration is also seen as a way of requesting blessings from the Lord, as most people believe that if one completes thewhole series of 9-day Masses, their wishes or prayers will be granted. Novenas are not magic, of course, and we avoid superstition with them. Ultimately, we are praying for God's will to be done with our intention/s.

This is the second year that Simbang Gabi will be celebrated in Ste. Anne's church. Simbang Gabi is an occasion to evangelize and deepen one's faith, build our communities, celebrate fellowship among other communities of different cultures, pray together, reach out to friends, re-live and share memories, impart to our young our culture and religious heritage, and above all, be ultimately blessed by our God.




Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament
